1976 CHAPTER xi

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936, relating to Strathclyde University and Mackintosh School of Architecture. [22nd July 1976]

WHEREAS the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed has been made by the Secretary of State under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936, and it is requisite that the said 1936 c. 52. Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Provisional Order contained in the schedule hereunto annexed is hereby confirmed. Confirmation

2. This Act may be cited as the Strathclyde University and Mackintosh School of Architecture Order Confirmation Act 1976. Short title.

SCHEDULE

STRATHCLYDE UNIVERSITY AND MACKINTOSH SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE

Provisional Order to provide for the inclusion in the composition of the Board of Architectural Education constituted under the Architects (Registration) Act 1931 of persons nominated by the School of Architecture, Building Science and Planning of the University of Strathclyde and the Mackintosh School of Architecture of the University of Glasgow.

Whereas—

(1) On the petition of the governing body of the Royal College of Science and Technology, Glasgow, Her Majesty on 23rd June, 1964, granted a charter constituting and founding a university by the style and name of “The University of Strathclyde” for, among other things, the advancement of knowledge, the diffusion and extension of arts, sciences and learning, the provision of liberal, professional, scientific and technological education and for the furtherance of the objects for which the Royal College of Science and Technology was constituted:

(2) The University of Strathclyde conducts in pursuit of its objects a School of Architecture, Building Science and Planning:

(3) There are in the City of Glasgow District two Schools of Architecture, namely the said School of Architecture, Building Science and Planning of the University of Strathclyde and the Mackintosh School of Architecture of the University of Glasgow:

(4) By the Architects (Registration) Act 1931 (hereinafter called “the Act of 1931”) there is constituted an Architects’ Registration Council of the United Kingdom (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) and it is the duty of the Council to maintain a register called the Register of Registered Architects:

(5) By section 5 of the Act of 1931 there is appointed annually by the Council a Board of Architectural Education (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) and it is the duty of the Board to recommend to the Council the recognition and holding of examinations for the qualification of applicants for registration under the Act and to hold examinations in accordance with the Act:

(6) The Board is constituted in accordance with the Second Schedule to the Act of 1931:

(7) The composition of the Board provides for the inclusion of one person nominated by the governing body of The Glasgow School of Architecture:

(8) The Glasgow School of Architecture took its origin from two bodies, namely the Glasgow School of Art and the Royal College of Science and Technology of Glasgow, the precursor of the University of Strathclyde:

(9) In 1964 The Glasgow School of Architecture ceased to exist and was dissolved:

(10) It is expedient that the City of Glasgow District should be represented on the Board and that the Act of 1931 should be amended as in this Order provided and that the other provisions in this Order should be enacted:

(11) The purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936:

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last-mentioned Act the Secretary of State orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Strathclyde University and Mackintosh School of Architecture Order 1976. Short title.

2. In the Second Schedule to the Architects (Registration) Act 1931, which specifies the constitution of the Board of Architectural Education, for the words "The Glasgow School of Architecture" there shall be substituted the words—

"The School of Architecture, Building Science and Planning,
University of Strathclyde.

3. All costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing for, obtaining and confirming this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the University of Strathclyde. Costs of Order.
