An Act to regulate the expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons by the Greater London Council during the financial period from 1st April 1979 to 30th September 1980; and for other purposes.

[6th December 1979]

HEREAS the London Government Act 1963 requires 1963 c. 33. that expenditure by the Greater London Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") on capital account or on lending to other persons shall be regulated by annual money Acts and that each of such Acts shall make provision for a period consisting of a financial year (that is to say a period of twelve months ending on 31st March) and the immediately following six months:

And whereas such a financial year and the immediately following six months are in the London Government Act 1963 and hereinafter together referred to as a "financial period":

And whereas such expenditure as aforesaid is, in relation to the financial period ending on 30th September 1979, regulated by the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1978:

And whereas it is expedient that the expenditure by the Council on capital account and on lending to other persons during the

financial period from 1st April 1979 to 30th September 1980 (hereinafter referred to as "the financial period 1979-1980") should be regulated as by this Act provided:

And whereas estimates have been prepared by the various committees of the Council of the amounts which may be required for the purposes of expenditure on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1979–1980 in the execution of the powers and duties respectively delegated to those committees; and all those estimates have been submitted to the Council and the estimates as so submitted have been adopted by the Council:

And whereas an estimate has been approved by the Inner London Education Authority of the amount which the said Authority may require in respect of expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1979–1980:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on capital account during the financial period 1979–1980 are the amounts specified in Part I of the schedule to this Act:

And whereas the sums estimated to be so required as aforesaid for expenditure on lending to other persons by the Council during the financial period 1979–1980 are the amounts specified in Part II of the said schedule:

And whereas the further sums which the Treasury in pursuance of the London Government Act 1963 may authorise the Council to expend on capital account and on lending to other persons during the financial period 1979-1980 are set out in Part III of the said schedule:

And whereas it is expedient that the other provisions contained in this Act should be enacted:

And whereas the objects of this Act cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Greater London Council (Money) Act 1979.

Interpretation.

- 2.—(1) In and for the purposes of this Act—
 - "the Act of 1963" means the London Government Act 1963;
 - "the Council" means the Greater London Council;

- "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;
- "the financial period 1979-1980", subject to the provisions of section 6 (Extension of Act in certain circumstances) of this Act, means the period from 1st April 1979 to 30th September 1980, both dates inclusive;
- "the financial year" means the period from 1st April 1979 to 31st March 1980, both dates inclusive;
- "the immediately following six months", subject to the provisions of section 6 (Extension of Act in certain circumstances) of this Act, means the period from 1st April 1980 to 30th September 1980, both dates inclusive;
- "the schedule" means the schedule to this Act.
- (2) In the schedule any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, extended or applied by any other enactment.
- 3.—(1) The purposes for which during the financial period Expenditure 1979-1980 the Council may under the powers of the Act of 1963 on capital expend money on capital account shall be the purposes mentioned account in the second column of Part I of the schedule.

- (2) The sums which during the said financial period the Council period may under the said powers expend on capital account shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed the amounts specified in the third and fourth columns respectively of Part I of the schedule in relation to the said purposes.
- 4.—(1) The persons to whom the Council may, under the Loans to powers of the Act of 1963, lend money during the financial period persons during 1979-1980 shall be the persons mentioned in the first column of financial Part II of the schedule. period 1979-1980.
- (2) The sums which during the said financial period may be so lent shall, as regards the financial year and the immediately following six months, be sums which, except as otherwise provided by the Act of 1963, shall not exceed the amounts specified in the second and third columns respectively of Part II of the schedule in relation to the said persons.
- 5. The sums which the Council may be authorised by the sums which Treasury under the powers of the Act of 1963 to expend on capital Treasury may account and on lending to other persons during the financial period authorise in account and on lending to other persons during the infanctal portoc case of 1979–1980, in case the amounts specified in Parts I and II of the insufficiency.

Extension of Act in certain circumstances.

- 6.—(1) The provisions of subsection (2) of this section shall have effect if a Bill (hereafter in this section referred to as "the 1980 Bill") which has been promoted by the Council in pursuance of paragraphs 25 to 29 of Schedule 2 to the Act of 1963 to make provision for the financial period commencing on 1st April 1980 has not been passed by 1st October 1980.
- (2) In the circumstances mentioned in the foregoing subsection, the provisions of this Act and of the said paragraphs 25 to 29 shall have effect as if any reference therein to the immediately following six months included a reference to the period from 1st October 1980 to the passing of the 1980 Bill and, accordingly, as if the financial period 1979–1980 consisted of the financial year and the immediately following six months (as extended by virtue of this subsection).

Saving.

7. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as authorising—
