1979 CHAPTER xxii

An Act to transfer the rights, properties and liabilities of that part of the University of London formerly known as University of London, University College to the Corporation of University College London and to achieve the re-unification of University College London and University College Hospital Medical School; and for other purposes. [20th December 1979]

WHEREAS—

(1) University of London, University College was founded in 1826, with the title “University of London”, under a deed of settlement executed on 11th February 1826. The foundation stone of the College building was laid on 30th April 1827, and courses of lectures in arts, laws and medicine began in October and November 1828:

(2) In 1836 a Royal Charter was granted, under which the proprietors of the institution hitherto known as the University of London were incorporated as University College London. On the same day a Royal Charter was granted to a separate body, to be known as the University of London (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) with powers to examine and grant degrees to persons holding certificates of having pursued courses of instruction approved by the University at University College London or elsewhere:

1869 c. xxiii. (3) In the course of years the number of proprietors gradually diminished, and in order to make provision for the permanent existence of the College as a public educational institution the University College (London) Act 1869 was enacted under which the deed of settlement and the Royal Charter granted to the College were annulled, and University College London was divested of its proprietary character and reincorporated with extended powers:

1898 c. 62. (4) The University was reconstituted by the University of London Act 1898, and the College was given a place in the University's constitution as a school of the University:

1905 c. xci. (5) Under the University College London (Transfer) Act 1905, University College London was on 1st January 1907 incorporated in the University and its properties, endowments, trusts and foundations were vested in the University, and the College's formal title was changed to University of London, University College:

(6) On 9th December 1977 the College was by Royal Charter disincorporated from the University and reconstituted as University College London (hereinafter referred to as "the College"):

(7) Plans showing the land vested in the University for the purposes of or in relation to University of London, University College were prepared in duplicate, one set of which was in the month of November, 1978 deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Parliaments, House of Lords and the other in the Private Bill Office, House of Commons:

(8) University College Hospital grew out of the University Dispensary, which opened in September 1828 and medical classes started there on 1st October 1828. The Dispensary was managed by the University of London, University College Council. In May, 1833 the foundation stone of the North London Hospital was laid on a site in Gower Street opposite University of London, University College and in 1837 the name was changed to University College Hospital:

(9) When the University was reconstituted in 1898 it was found that the University could not easily incorporate the Hospital nor that part of the Faculty of Medicine dealing with final medical studies. It was therefore decided that the teaching of final medical studies should be carried out by a new corporation and that the teaching of preliminary and intermediate medical studies should continue in University of London, University College premises:

(10) The University College London (Transfer) Act 1905 also provided for the formation of a separate body corporate by the name of North London or University College Hospital for the purposes of carrying on the Hospital and Medical School. From

1907 until 1948 University College Hospital Medical School (hereinafter referred to as "the School") and the Hospital were administered as one. As a result of the National Health Service Act 1946, the School was given a new scheme of incorporation in 1948 by which it became a body corporate with its own governing body and having perpetual succession and a common seal, and became administered separately from the Hospital as an independent school of the University: 1946 c. 81.

(11) The report of the Royal Commission on Medical Education 1968, under the chairmanship of Lord Todd, envisaged a reunion between University College London and University College Hospital Medical School. After extensive deliberations culminating in a report accepted by the Councils of the two institutions and by the University, the College and the School resolved to achieve reunification:

(12) The object of this Act cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the University College London Short title. Act 1979.

2. In this Act, unless the subject or context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:— Interpretation.

"the charter" means the Royal Charter granted by Her Majesty on 9th December 1977 and includes any amendment, alteration or addition thereto;

"the College" means University College London;

"the council" means the council of the College;

"the plans" means the plans deposited as recited in the Preamble to this Act;

"the University" means the University of London.

3.—(1) The property of the University which is specified in subsection (2) of this section shall, subject to the provisions of this Act, by virtue of this Act, without any conveyance, transfer, assignment or other instrument, be transferred to and vested in the College for all the estate and interest therein of the University, and shall be applied to the objects and purposes of the College as contained in the charter. Transfer of property to College.

(2) The property of the University transferred to the College by virtue of subsection (1) of this section shall be the freehold interests vested in the University in the properties referred to in Part I of Schedule 1 to this Act and the leasehold interests vested in the University in the properties referred to in Part II of Schedule 1 to this Act, but as regards so much of the property numbered 6 on Plan 1 as is known as 2-28 Gordon Street and 13-24 Taviton Street such transfer shall have effect subject to the provisions set forth in Part III of Schedule 1 to this Act.

(3) At any time or times after the commencement of this Act the University may if it thinks it necessary or convenient so to do with the consent in writing of the College convey, transfer, assign or otherwise assure to or vest in the College any property of any description (not being property transferred to the College by virtue of subsection (1) of this section) which immediately before the commencement of this Act belonged to or was vested in the University for the purposes of University of London, University College and any property so conveyed, transferred, assigned or otherwise assured to or vested in the College shall, subject to the provisions of this Act, be applied to the objects and purposes of the College as contained in the charter.

(4) The College shall indemnify Her Majesty's Chief Land Registrar against any claim which may be made against him under the Land Registration Acts 1925 to 1971 (or any Act amending or replacing the same) consequent upon the registration of title to any freehold or leasehold land transferred to the College by virtue of this section.

Transfer of
trust property
and adaptation
of trusts.

4.—(1) In relation to the trusts specified in Schedule 2 to this Act (being trusts for particular purposes or objects connected with University of London, University College of which the University was sole trustee immediately before the commencement of this Act)—

- (a) upon the commencement of this Act and without any deed of appointment or retirement or other instrument the College shall become the sole trustee thereof in place of the University which shall cease to be a trustee thereof;
- (b) the property of every description subject thereto shall without any conveyance, transfer, assignment or other instrument be transferred to and vested in the College for all the estate and interest therein of the University.

(2) In relation to trusts (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to this Act) established or regulated by any scheme, deed, will or other instrument or otherwise howsoever of which the University

was the sole trustee immediately before the commencement of this Act, and which subsist for particular purposes or objects connected with University of London, University College and for no other purposes or objects and free from any gift over in favour of any other person or purpose or object, the University shall as soon as practicable after the commencement of this Act by deed or deeds or other appropriate instrument appoint the College to be the sole trustee thereof in place of the University (which shall retire as trustee) and transfer or otherwise assure to or vest in the College all property of every description which may be subject thereto.

(3) Any property which by virtue of any trust to which subsection (1) or (2) of this section applies is held upon trust for any specific foundation or object or purpose of University of London, University College or for any specific foundation or object or purpose of the University which is connected with University of London, University College or is otherwise held upon trust in such a way as to be connected with University of London, University College shall after the commencement of this Act (and in the case of any trust to which subsection (2) of this section applies whether or not the College has been appointed sole trustee thereof in accordance with that subsection) be held upon trust for and applied, so far as is possible, to the equivalent foundation or object or purpose of the College or held upon trust in such a way as to be connected with the College in the like manner as it was formerly connected with University of London, University College:

Provided that—

- (a) any such foundation or object or purpose may from time to time be varied or added to, by deed under the common seal of the College which shall have been approved by a special resolution (as defined by the charter) of the council of the College but so that the funds and investments for the time being allocated to each specific foundation or object or purpose shall remain allocated for that specific foundation or object or purpose; and
- (b) any such deed shall not be of any validity until the same shall have been submitted to and approved by the Privy Council and a certificate of their approval thereof, signed by the Clerk of the Privy Council, shall be endorsed on the deed.

5. All debts and liabilities of the University in relation to University of London, University College shall, by virtue of this Act, be transferred and attached to the College and shall thereafter be discharged and satisfied by the College. Transfer of liabilities.

Savings for agreements, deeds, actions, etc.

6. All agreements, appointments, awards, contracts, deeds and other instruments, and all actions and proceedings and causes of actions or proceedings, which immediately before the commencement of this Act were existing or pending in favour of, or against, the University for the purposes of or in relation to University of London, University College, shall continue and may be carried into effect, enforced and prosecuted by, or in favour of, or against, the College to the same extent and in like manner as if the College instead of the University had been party to, or interested in, the same respectively.

Transfer of powers to appoint or nominate.

7. Any power or right vested in the University, for the purposes of or in relation to University of London, University College, to appoint or nominate a member of any educational authority, or of the governing body of any educational, charitable or other institution, shall on the commencement of this Act be transferred to, and may be exercised by, the College.

Construction of bequests.

8. Any scheme, will, deed or other instrument, whether made or executed before or after the commencement of this Act (including any will made before the commencement of this Act by a testator living at the commencement of this Act), which contains any bequest, gift or trust or other benefit in favour of University of London, University College or in favour of the University for the purposes of or in relation to University of London, University College shall, on and after the commencement of this Act, be read and have effect as if the College were therein named, instead of University of London, University College or the University as the case may be.

Repeals.

9. The enactments specified in Schedule 3 to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent mentioned in the third column of that Schedule.

Appointment of College as trustee of University College Pool.

10.—(1) Upon the commencement of this Act—

- (a) without any deed of appointment or retirement or other instrument the College shall become the sole trustee of the University College Pool in place of the University which shall cease to be a trustee thereof;
- (b) the property of every description comprised in the University College Pool shall without any conveyance, transfer, assignment or other instrument be transferred to and vested in the College;

and thereafter the scheme shall continue in full force and effect as two separate common investment schemes in relation to the University College Pool and the University Pool respectively.

(2) In this section—

“ the scheme ” means the common investment scheme constituted by—

(i) an order dated 30th November 1959 of the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division, made by the Honourable Mr. Justice Wynn-Parry in proceedings the short title and reference to the record whereof is “ Re Charitable Trusts of the University of London 1958 U 666 ”;

(ii) an order dated 8th November 1963 of the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division, made by the Honourable Mr. Justice Wilberforce in proceedings the short title and reference to the record whereof is “ Re Charitable Trusts of the University of London 1963 U 921 ”;

(iii) an order dated 6th March 1978 of the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division, made by the Honourable Mr. Justice Templeman in proceedings the short title and reference to the record whereof is “ In the matter of the Charitable Trusts of which the University of London are the trustees 1977 U 1738 ”;

“ the University Pool ” means the pool of investments referred to in paragraph 1 of the said order dated 30th November 1959 and in paragraph 1 (a) of each of the said orders dated 8th November 1963 and 6th March 1978;

“ the University College Pool ” means the pool of investments referred to in paragraph 2 of the said order dated 30th November 1959 and in paragraph 1 (c) of the said order dated 8th November 1963.

11.—(1) As from the commencement of this section the School shall be dissolved and cease to exist and at that date the scheme made pursuant to section 15 of the National Health Service Act 1946 constituting the governing body of the School defining the duties and powers of that body and providing for the future management and control of the School shall be revoked.

(2) Subject to the provisions of this section all property, real and personal, of every description, including things in action, and all rights and privileges of the School which immediately before the commencement of this section belonged to or were vested in or exercisable by them shall by virtue of this section without any conveyance, transfer, assignment or other instrument be transferred to, vested in and exercisable by the College for all the estate and interest therein of the School.

(3) On the commencement of this section all debts and liabilities of the School shall, by virtue of this section, be transferred and attached to the College and shall thereafter be discharged and satisfied by the College.

(4) All agreements, appointments, awards, contracts, deeds and other instruments, and all actions and proceedings and causes of actions or proceedings, which immediately before the commencement of this section were existing or pending in favour of, or against, the School shall continue and may be carried into effect, enforced and prosecuted by, or in favour of, or against, the College to the same extent and in like manner as if the College instead of the School had been party to, or interested in, the same respectively.

(5) Any scheme, will, deed or other instrument, whether made or executed before or after the commencement of this section (including any will made before the commencement of this section by a testator living at the commencement of this section), which contains any bequest, gift or trust or other benefit in favour of the School shall, on and after the commencement of this section, be read and have effect as if the College were therein named, instead of the School.

(6) In this section "the School" means the University College Hospital Medical School.

(7) This section shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

Costs of Act.

12. The costs, charges and expenses preliminary, or incidental, to the preparation of, and the application for, and the obtaining and passing of, this Act shall be paid by the College out of the funds of the College.

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PROVISIONS AFFECTING 2-28 GORDON STREET AND 13-24 TAVITON STREET

1. The following are included in the transfer of the property to the College effected by section 3 (Transfer of property to College) of this Act:—

- (a) the right of support from the adjoining property of the University now known as 14 Taviton Street (formerly part of 34 and 35 Gordon Square), 29 Gordon Square and 30 to 34 inclusive Gordon Square (excluding the buildings comprised therein) for the land and buildings comprised in the property;
- (b) the right to use for all proper purposes connected with the property any sewers, drains, watercourses, pipes, cables, wires or other channels or conductors in, under or over the said adjoining property of the University with power at any time or times to enter thereupon for the purpose of making connections with, repairing, renewing, maintaining, inspecting or cleansing the same.

2. The following are excepted and reserved out of the property to the University in fee simple for the benefit of its said adjoining property:—

- (a) the right to use in the event of fire or other emergency the external fire escape staircase existing on the property at the commencement of this Act and the then existing means of access to and from such fire escape staircase:

Provided always that in the event of the College needing to demolish the said fire escape staircase the College may by not less than three months' previous notice in writing to the University determine the said right;

- (b) the right to continue to discharge an extract fan as now existing on 29 Gordon Square over the said fire escape staircase referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above:

Provided always that the College may by not less than three months' previous notice in writing to the University determine the said right;

- (c) the right of support from the land comprised in the property to the said adjoining property of the University (including the buildings comprised therein);
- (d) the right to use for all proper purposes connected with the said adjoining property of the University any sewers, drains, watercourses, pipes, cables, wires or other channels or conductors in, under or over the property, with power at any time or times to enter thereupon for the purpose of making connections with, repairing, renewing, maintaining, inspecting or cleansing the same;
- (e) the right to light and air to the basement windows of the Institutes of Archaeology and Classical Studies;

(f) the right to enter upon the property for the purpose of carrying out maintenance and repairs or building works to the said adjoining property which cannot conveniently be carried out from such adjoining property the University making good all damage to the property thereby occasioned.

3. The College will not without the prior consent in writing of the University use or occupy or cause or allow to be used or occupied for purposes not connected with the University or the College the whole or any part or parts of the land forming the site of 2-28 Gordon Street and 13-24 Taviton Street.
