**1980 CHAPTER xxxi**

An Act to extend the time for the completion of the works authorised by the Falmouth Container Terminal Act 1971; and for connected purposes. [1st August 1980]

**W**HEREAS by the Falmouth Container Terminal Act 1971, 1971 c. v. the Falmouth Container Terminal Limited was authorised to construct certain works in the district of Carrick in the county of Cornwall:

And whereas by virtue of the said Act of 1971 the powers thereby granted for making and completing the said authorised works are to cease on 30th September 1980:

And whereas it is expedient that the time so limited should be extended as by this Act provided:

And whereas it is expedient that the other provisions of this Act be enacted:

And whereas the objects of this Act cannot be attained without authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and

with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Falmouth Container Terminal Act 1980 and the Falmouth Container Terminal Act 1971 and this Act may be cited as the Falmouth Container Terminal Acts 1971 and 1980.

Extension of  
time.

2. The period now limited by the Falmouth Container Terminal Act 1971 for the completion of works authorised by section 4 (Power to construct works) of that Act is hereby extended until 30th September 1988 and accordingly in section 10 (Period for completion of works) of the said Act for the words “within ten years from 1st October 1970” there shall be substituted the words “before 1st October 1988” and the words “on the expiration of that period” shall be omitted.
