*Provisional Orders Confirmation (Housing of Working
Classes) Act, 1903.*



CHAPTER lxxv.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Government Board for Ireland relating to the Urban Districts of Athlone and Kingstown (two). A.D. 1903.

[21st July 1903.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Local Government Board") have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890 :

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament and that the provisions herein contained should be enacted with reference to two of such Orders :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in schedule confirmed.

2. The urban district council of Athlone shall not under the powers of the Athlone Order 1903 purchase or acquire ten or more houses which on the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either wholly or partly by persons belonging to the labouring class as tenants or lodgers or except with the consent of the Local Government Board ten or more houses which were not so occupied on the said fifteenth day of December but have been or will be subsequently so occupied. Restriction of power to take houses of labouring class.

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Special provisions as to
Kingstown.

3. The following provisions shall apply to the urban district council of Kingstown (herein-after referred to as "the Council") :—

(1) The Council shall not under the powers of the Kingstown (No. 2) Order 1903 hereby confirmed purchase or acquire ten or more houses which on the fifteenth day of December last were or have been since that day or shall hereafter be occupied either wholly or partially by persons belonging to the labouring class as tenants or lodgers unless and until—

(a) They shall have obtained the approval of the Local Government Board to a scheme for providing new dwellings for such number of persons as were residing in such houses on the fifteenth day of December last or for such number of persons as the Local Government Board shall after inquiry deem necessary having regard to the number of persons on or after that date residing in such houses and working within one mile therefrom and to the amount of vacant suitable accommodation in the immediate neighbourhood of such houses or to the place of employment of such persons and to all the circumstances of the case ; and

(b) They shall have given security to the satisfaction of the Local Government Board for the carrying out of the scheme.

(2) The approval of the Local Government Board to any scheme under this section may be given either absolutely or conditionally and after the Local Government Board have approved of any such scheme they may from time to time approve either absolutely or conditionally of any modifications in the scheme.

(3) Every scheme under this section shall contain provisions prescribing the time within which it shall be carried out and shall require the new dwellings proposed to be provided under the scheme to be completed fit for occupation before the persons residing in the houses in respect of which the scheme is made are displaced :

Provided that the Local Government Board may dispense with the last-mentioned requirement subject to such conditions if any as they may see fit.

(4) Any provisions of any scheme under this section or any conditions subject to which the Local Government Board may have approved of any scheme or of any modifications

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of any scheme or subject to which they may have dispensed with the above-mentioned requirement shall be enforceable by writ of mandamus to be obtained by the Local Government Board out of the High Court. A.D. 1903.

- (5) For the purpose of carrying out any scheme under this section the Council may appropriate and use any lands for the time being belonging to them or which they have power to acquire :

Provided that nothing in this section shall relieve the Council from the necessity of obtaining the approval of the Local Government Board to such appropriation or use as would require such approval under any general Act.

- (6) If the Council acquire or appropriate any house or houses for the purposes of the Kingstown (No. 2) Order 1903 or of any scheme under this section in contravention of the foregoing provisions or displace or cause to be displaced the persons residing in any house or houses in contravention of the requirements of the scheme they shall be liable to a penalty of five hundred pounds in respect of every such house which penalty shall be recoverable by the Local Government Board by action in the High Court and shall be carried to and form part of the Consolidated Fund of the United Kingdom. Provided that the court may if it think fit reduce such penalty.

- (7) Subject to the provisions of this section the Council and the Local Government Board and their inspectors shall have and may exercise for any purpose in connexion with any scheme under this section all or any of the powers vested in them under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 in the same manner in every respect as if the preparation and carrying into effect of such scheme were one of the general purposes of that Act :

Provided that all lands on which any buildings have been erected or provided by the Council in pursuance of any scheme under this section shall for a period of twenty-five years from the date of the scheme be appropriated for the purpose of dwellings and every conveyance demise or lease of such lands and buildings shall be endorsed with notice of this enactment :

Provided also that the Local Government Board may at any time dispense with all or any of the requirements of

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this subsection subject to such conditions if any as they may see fit.

(8) The Council shall pay to the Local Government Board a sum to be fixed by that Board in respect of the preparation and issue of any Provisional Order in pursuance of this section and any expenses incurred by that Board in relation to any inquiries under this section including the expenses of any witnesses summoned by the inspector holding the inquiry and a sum to be fixed by that Board not exceeding three guineas a day for the services of such inspector.

(9) The amount of money to be borrowed by the Council under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 for the purposes of the Kingstown (Nos. 1 and 2) Orders 1903 hereby confirmed and of carrying out the schemes under Parts I. and III. of the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890 for which the lands mentioned in those Orders are required shall not be restricted by the limitation on borrowing contained in subsections (2) and (3) of section 238 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and in calculating the amount which the Council may borrow under the last-mentioned Act any money borrowed by the Council for the purposes of the Kingstown (Nos. 1 and 2) Orders 1903 and of carrying out the said schemes shall not be reckoned.

Definition of
labouring
class.

4. For the purposes of sections two and three of this Act the expression "labouring class" means mechanics artizans labourers and others working for wages hawkers costermongers persons not working for wages but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others except members of their own families and persons other than domestic servants whose income does not exceed an average of thirty shillings a week and the families of any of such persons who may be residing with them.

Short title.

5. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (Housing of Working Classes) Act 1903.

WHEREAS the urban district council of Athlone (in this Order referred to as "the sanitary authority") are the sanitary authority of the urban sanitary district consisting of the town of Athlone and have adopted Part III. of the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890 and require to purchase and take the lands described in the schedule hereto for the purposes of the said Part III. of the said Act:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board for Ireland in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 57 of the said Act and by section 203 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect namely:—

1. The sanitary authority shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands described in the schedule hereto and for the purposes aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. The costs and expenses of the sanitary authority and of the Local Government Board for Ireland incurred in respect of the application for preparation making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the sanitary authority out of the rate leviable under section 60 of the Towns Improvement (Ireland) Act 1854 as amended by any enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Athlone Order 1903.

*Provisional Order for confirming an Improvement Scheme under
Part I. of the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890.*

WHEREAS the Urban District Council of Kingstown (in this Order referred to as "the local authority") are the sanitary authority of the urban sanitary district consisting of the township of Kingstown in the county of Dublin :

And whereas an official representation has been made to the local authority in pursuance of Part I. of the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890 (in this Order referred to as "the Act") with reference to an unhealthy area in the said township called Molloy's Court Clark's Court Kelly's Court Sexton's Court Hilton's Court Byrne's Court Cumberland Street and York Street unhealthy area which unhealthy area comprises the area described in the deposited plan and book of reference herein-after referred to :

And whereas the local authority being satisfied of the truth of the said representation and of the sufficiency of their resources have passed a resolution that the area described in the said representation is an unhealthy area and have made a Scheme for the improvement thereof :

And whereas the Scheme was accompanied by a plan and by particulars and an estimate and the Scheme particulars and estimate are as follows :—

" URBAN DISTRICT OF KINGSTOWN.

" In the matter of the Housing of the Working Classes Act 1890 (53 and 54 Vict. c. 70).

" PART I.

" SCHEME of the Kingstown Urban District Council for the improvement of an
" unhealthy area called Molloy's Court Clark's Court Kelly's Court Sexton's Court
" Hilton's Court Byrne's Court Cumberland Street and York Street unhealthy area.

" 1. The Scheme may be cited 'the Kingstown Improvement Scheme 1902.'

" 2. In this Scheme 'the Council' means the Kingstown Urban District Council
" 'the clerk' and 'the surveyor' mean respectively the clerk to the said Council and

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“ the surveyor to said Urban District of Kingstown and ‘ the plan ’ means the map or
“ plan which accompanies this Scheme. A.D. 1903.

“ 3. The unhealthy area included in this Scheme is the area delineated and indicated
“ on the plan A duplicate of the plan is deposited at the office of the clerk Town
“ Hall Kingstown Copies of the plan or of any part or parts thereof certified by the
“ surveyor shall be received in all courts of justice and elsewhere as evidence of
“ the contents thereof respectively.

“ 4. This Scheme comprises and will include in its operation the following courts
“ streets or roads known as Molloy’s Court Clark’s Court Kelly’s Court Sexton’s
“ Court Hilton’s Court Byrne’s Court Cumberland Street and York Street in the Urban
“ District of Kingstown in the county of Dublin.

“ 5. The Council may take compulsorily enter on and deal with for the purposes of
“ this Scheme all or any of the lands delineated on the plan.

“ 6. The Council may widen existing approaches to and communications through
“ the said unhealthy area and they may lay out form sewer pave and complete
“ such new streets or roads and may make all such alterations or level diversions or
“ stoppings up as are shown on the plan or as they may hereafter determine to be
“ necessary and proper for opening out the said unhealthy area for the purpose of this
“ Scheme and of ventilation or health.

“ 7. The Council may from time to time appropriate any parts of the said area for the
“ erection thereon of suitable dwellings for the working classes and they shall provide
“ either by such appropriation parts of the said area and by securing the erection
“ of suitable dwellings thereon or in some other manner for the accommodation of at
“ least as many persons of the working class as will be from time to time displaced
“ within the unhealthy area.

“ 8. The dwelling houses to be erected in accordance with this Scheme shall be well
“ and substantially built and shall be so situated and constructed as to secure efficient
“ ventilation and shall be furnished with a proper and sufficient water supply and with
“ proper drainage and other sanitary appliances and apparatus to the satisfaction
“ of the Council and the Council shall enforce the execution and maintenance of all
“ proper sanitary arrangements within the area shown on the plan.

“ 9. The Council shall as soon as practicable after the passing of the Act confirming
“ the Provisional Order authorising this Scheme or a modification thereof proceed to
“ carry the same into execution but they may from time to time purchase and deal
“ with part of the lands and premises within the area delineated without being
“ required to purchase and deal with the whole of the lands and premises within the
“ said area.

“ 10. The expenses of the execution of this Scheme or any modification thereof (so
“ far as they are not defrayed out of receipts of the Council pursuant to the Artizans
“ and Labourers Dwellings Improvement Acts 1875 and 1879) and the costs charges
“ and expenses preliminary to and of and incidental to the preparation of this Scheme
“ and the application for the Provisional Order confirming the same and the obtaining
“ the confirmation by Parliament of such Order shall be paid by the Council out of the
“ local rates or out of moneys borrowed in pursuance of the said Acts.

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order as follows :—

1. We confirm the said scheme so far as its provisions are authorised by and in accordance with the Act and subject to the modifications herein-after mentioned.

Limits of area.

2. We declare that the limits of the area comprised in the scheme are those delineated and described in the deposited plan and book of reference.

Authorisation

3. We authorise the scheme to be carried into execution subject to the following conditions and modifications namely :—

(1) New houses shall not without the consent of the Local Government Board be erected on the area comprised in the scheme to a greater extent than is required for the accommodation of the same number of

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persons as at the date of the Act confirming this Order may be resident in that area : A.D. 1903.

(2) Provision for the accommodation of the working classes shall be made in accordance with subsection (2) of section 11 of the Act. *Kingstown.*
