



CHAPTER cviii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Government Board for Ireland relating to Birr Dunganvaran Londonderry Trim and Tuam (Rural). A.D. 1906.

[20th July 1906.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland (in this Act referred to as "the Local Government Board") have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the Public Health (Ireland) Acts 1878 to 1896 :

42 & 43 Vict. c. 57.
47 & 48 Vict. c. 77.
52 & 53 Vict. c. 54.
53 & 54 Vict. c. 59.
59 & 60 Vict. c. 54.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament and that the provisions herein contained should be enacted with reference to certain of those Orders :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in schedule confirmed.

2. The sanitary authorities mentioned in the Orders hereby confirmed relating to urban districts shall not under the powers of those Orders purchase or acquire in any urban district any house or houses which on the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either wholly or partially by thirty or more persons belonging to the working class as tenants or lodgers or except with the consent of the Local Government Board any house or houses which were not so occupied on the said fifteenth day of December but have been or will be subsequently so occupied. If the said authorities acquire or appropriate any house or houses for the purposes of those Orders in contravention of the foregoing provisions they shall be liable to a penalty of five hundred pounds in respect of every such house which penalty shall be recoverable by the Local Government Board by action in the High Court and shall be carried to and form part of the Consolidated Fund of the United Kingdom Provided that the Court may if it think fit reduce such penalty.

For the purposes of this section the expression "house" means any house or part of a house occupied as a separate dwelling and the expression "working class" means mechanics artizans labourers and others working for wages hawkers costermongers persons not working for wages but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others except members of their own families and persons other than domestic servants whose income does not exceed an average of thirty shillings a week and the families of any such persons who may be residing with them.

Increase of borrowing powers by urban district council of Birr under 41 & 42 Vict. c. 52.

3. The amount which the urban district council of Birr may borrow under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 for the purposes of the Birr Order 1906 hereby confirmed and of carrying out the scheme for which the lands mentioned in that Order are required shall be increased by a sum not exceeding three thousand pounds and in calculating the amount which that council may borrow under the said Act any additional sum borrowed by them in pursuance of this section shall not be reckoned.

4. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 2) Act 1906.

The costs and expenses of the district council and the Local Government Board for Ireland incurred in respect of the application for preparation making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the district council out of the rate applicable by that council to defray the expenses incurred by them in the execution of the Public Health (Ireland) Acts 1878 to 1896.
