



Dean Forest Act 1906

1906 CHAPTER cxix 6 Edw 7

1 Power to exchange parcels of waste in Forest of Dean.

It shall be lawful for the [^{F1}Forestry Commissioners] with the consent of the Treasury and the verderers of the Forest of Dean to enter into and carry into effect agreements for causing any parcel of the waste in the Forest of Dean not exceeding one thousand pounds in value to be freed from the rights of common to which it may at the date of the agreement be subject and for causing by way of exchange any parcel of freehold land within the said forest forming part of the possessions and land revenues of the Crown and not being part of the said waste to be made part of the said waste and subject to the like rights of common and any such agreement upon the execution thereof shall have full force and effect according to the tenour thereof.
