

CHAPTER cxxviii.

An Act to discharge certain surcharges made upon the A.D. 1909. accounts of the Municipal Corporation of Dublin.

[16th August 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. All surcharges made at the audit of the accounts of Remission of the Municipal Corporation of Dublin for the periods respectively surcharges. ended the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and six and the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and seven in respect of payments made for the purposes of the public libraries of the city of Dublin are hereby discharged and any proceedings commenced or taken to recover the amount of any such surcharges are hereby annulled.

- 2. There shall be paid by the Corporation to the auditor all Payment of costs necessarily and properly incurred by the auditor in and auditor's costs. about the proceedings hereby annulled.
- 3. This Act may be cited as the Remission of Surcharges Short title. (Dublin) Act 1909.
