



CHAPTER xxiii

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Housing and Local Government relating to the borough of Brighouse. [19th July, 1962]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act, 1875, and the Public Health Act, 1936, the Minister of Housing and Local Government has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The order of the Minister of Housing and Local Government which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. Confirmation of order in schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Housing and Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation (Brighouse) Act, 1962. Short title.

SCHEDULE

BOROUGH OF BRIGHOUSE

Provisional Order partially repealing a Local Act

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the application of the council of the borough of Brighouse, in exercise of his powers under section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and
commence-
ment.

1. This order may be cited as the Brighouse Order 1962 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpreta-
tion.

2. In this order—

“the relevant building byelaws” means the building bye-laws made by the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Brighouse acting by the council for the borough of Brighouse, on the 3rd October 1960 which include a byelaw applying the provisions of section 53 of the Public Health Act 1936 (relating to buildings constructed of materials which are short lived or otherwise unsuitable for use in permanent buildings) to materials specified in the byelaw; and

“the operative date” means the date on which the relevant building byelaws come into operation, or the date on which this order comes into operation, whichever is the later.

Partial repeal
of Local Act.

3. Subject as hereinafter provided, section 20 of the Brighouse Corporation Act 1907 (Temporary and movable buildings) shall be repealed as from the operative date:

Provided that this repeal shall not operate so as to affect any approval given subject to conditions in respect of any temporary or movable building before the operative date, and the said section 20 shall continue to have effect in relation to any such building in respect of which such approval has been given.
