



CHAPTER xxv

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Housing and Local Government relating to the urban district Sidmouth.
[19th July, 1962]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act, 1875, the Public Health Act, 1936, and the Food and Drugs Act, 1955, the Minister of Housing and Local Government has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The order of the Minister of Housing and Local Government Confirmation which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed of order in and shall have full validity and force. schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Housing and Local Short title.

SCHEDULE

URBAN DISTRICT OF SIDMOUTH
Provisional Order amending a Local Act

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the application of the urban district council of Sidmouth and in exercise of his powers under section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875, section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936 and section 131 of the Food and Drugs Act 1955, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and
commence-
ment.

1. This order may be cited as the Sidmouth Order 1962 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpre-
tation.

2. In this order, “the Act of 1839” means the Local Act 2 & 3 Vict. c. lxxxi for maintaining and regulating the market in the parish of Sidmouth.

Amendment
of local Act.

3. Section IV of the Act of 1839 (which now empowers the Council as the owners of the said market to receive the several tolls, duties, rents and stallage not exceeding those contained in the schedule to the said Act) shall have effect as if the following paragraph were contained therein:—

“The Owners for the Time being of the Market may, with the approval of the Minister of Housing and Local Government, from time to time alter or add to the Tolls, Duties, Rents and Stallage mentioned, expressed or contained in the said Schedule”.

Local
inquiries.

4.—(1) The Minister of Housing and Local Government may cause such local inquiry to be held as he may consider necessary for the purpose of any of the functions under the said Act of 1839 as amended by this order.
(2) Subsections (2) to (5) of section 290 of the Local Government Act 1933 (which relate to the giving of evidence at inquiries and the payment of costs) shall apply to inquiries held under this article.
