



CHAPTER i

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936 relating to Clyde Navigation. [28th November 1956.]

WHEREAS the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed has been made by the Secretary of State under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936 and it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Provisional Order contained in the schedule hereunto annexed is hereby confirmed. Confirmation of Order in schedule.
2. This Act may be cited as the Clyde Navigation Order Confirmation Act 1956. Short title.

SCHEDULE

CLYDE NAVIGATION

Provisional Order to extend the period for the compulsory purchase of certain lands by the Trustees of the Clyde Navigation and for other purposes.

Whereas the Trustees of the Clyde Navigation (hereinafter called "the Trustees") were incorporated by the Clyde Navigation Consolidation Act 1858:

And whereas the Trustees were authorised by the Clyde Navigation Order 1914 and the Clyde Navigation Order 1950 to construct certain works and for that purpose to acquire certain lands by compulsory purchase:

And whereas it is expedient that the period now limited for the compulsory purchase of the said lands should be extended as provided by this Order:

And whereas the purpose aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936:

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last-mentioned Act the Secretary of State orders as follows:—

Short and
collective titles.

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Clyde Navigation Order 1956.

(2) The Clyde Navigation Acts 1858 to 1955 and this Order may be cited together as the Clyde Navigation Acts 1858 to 1956.

Extending
period for
compulsory

2. Section 11 (Revival of powers for compulsory purchase of land) and section 18 (Period for compulsory purchase of lands) of the Clyde Navigation Order 1950 as amended by section 2 of the Clyde Navigation Order 1953 shall each be read and have effect as if for the reference therein to the first day of October one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six there were substituted a reference to the first day of October one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.

Costs of Order.

3. All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for obtaining and confirming of this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Trustees of the Clyde Navigation out of the revenues of their undertaking.
