His Majesty empowered to grant Letters Patent for licenfing a The tre at Gla/gow,

of Westminster, or where His Majesty is residing for the Time being, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same respects the City of Glasgow, Suburbs, or Neighbourhood thereof; and that it shall and may be lawful to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, to grant Letters Patent for establishing a Theatre or Play-House in the City of Glasgow, Suburbs, or Neighbourhood thereof, subject to such Restrictions as to the Number of Persons to be interested therein, and in the Profits thereof, and with fuch Privileges, and under such Provisions and Regulations for the due and orderly conducting and managing the same, as to His Majesty shall seem fit.

subject to the Controul of the Magiftrates.

II. Provided always, and be it enacted, That the said Theatre or Play-House, and Management thereof, shall be under and subject to the Controul and Inspection of the Lord Provost, Baillies, Dean of Guild, and Deacon Convener of the Trades of the City of Glasgow, and of the Sheriff Depute of the County of Lanark for the Time being.

Publick Act.

III. And it is hereby enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a publick Act, and shall be taken Notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, in all Courts and Places without specially pleading the fame.
