## Cap. 106.

An Act to continue Two Acts of the Parliament of  
*Ireland*, for the Improvement of the Harbour of  
*Drogheda*. [18th June 1808.]

**W**HEREAS an Act was made in the Parliament of *Ireland*, in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the Improvement of the Port and Harbour of Drogheda, and the better Regulation of the Police of said Town*: And whereas One other Act was made in the Parliament of *Ireland*, in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled ' *An Act to amend an Act passed in the Thirtieth Year of His present Majesty's Reign intituled ' An Act for the Improvement of the Port and Harbour of Drogheda, and the better Regulation of the Police of said Town* : ' And whereas the Tonnage Duties levied and received under the said recited Acts will soon expire ; and the Works of the said Port and Harbour cannot be maintained unless the said Acts, so far as relate to the said Port and Harbour, are further continued : May it therefore please Your Majesty, That it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the said recited Acts, so far as the same respect the Improvement of the Port and Harbour of *Drogheda*, and the levying and collecting the Duties of Tonnage on

Ships and Vessels entering the same shall be, and the same are hereby further continued during the Period hereinafter mentioned.

II. And be it further enacted, That the Commissioners acting under the said recited Acts, or any Seven of them, shall be, and they are hereby authorized and required to draw on their Treasurer for such Sum or Sums of Money as may be necessary to defray the Expences of obtaining and passing this Act; and the said Treasurer shall be, and he is hereby empowered to pay the same out of the Funds arising from the Tonnage Rates, and Duties levied, or to be levied in pursuance of the said Acts, and this Act, which shall be allowed in his Accounts.

Public Act.

III. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a public Act, and shall be judicially taken Notice of as such, by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.

Continuance.

IV. And be it further enacted, That the said recited Acts and this Act shall continue in Force for One Year, and until the End of the then next Session of Parliament.
