



**CHAPTER cxlv.**

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Government Board relating to East Westmorland (Rural) Ilfracombe Leigh-on-Sea and Windermere. A.D. 1911.

[18th August 1911.]

**W**HEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—
