



### CHAPTER cliv.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders made by the Board of Education under the Education Acts 1870 to 1907 to enable the Councils of the Administrative Counties of Durham Montgomery and Worcester and the Urban District of Willesden to put in force the Lands Clauses Acts. [18th August 1911.] A.D. 1911.

**W**HEREAS the Board of Education have made certain Provisional Orders under the authority of the Education Acts 1870 to 1907 on behalf of the councils of the administrative counties of Durham Montgomery and Worcester and the urban district of Willesden being the local education authorities under the Education Act 1902 for the said administrative counties and urban district and it is requisite that the same should be confirmed by Parliament:

And whereas the lands required to be purchased under the powers granted by the said Provisional Orders and confirmed by this Act are severally described in the schedules to the said Provisional Orders as set out in the schedule to this Act and are delineated on the plans accompanying the respective petitions referred to in the said Provisional Orders and copies of all the said plans have been duly deposited in the offices of the two Houses of Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The following Orders as set out in the schedule to this Act shall be and are hereby confirmed and from and after the passing of this Act shall have full validity and force.
