

CHAPTER cxii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the A.D. 1920.

Minister of Health relating to Bognor Bradford Keighley
Southend-on-Sea Tynemouth and the Rochester and
Chatham Joint Sewerage District. [4th August 1920.]

WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:

38 & 39 Vict.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The Orders as altered and set out in the schedule hereto Orders in shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions schedule confirmed. thereof shall have full validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Short title. Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 5) Act 1920.

URBAN DISTRICT OF BOGNOR.

Bognor Order. Provisional Order to enable the Urban District Council of Bognor to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

To the Urban District Council of Bognor; -

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Urban District Council of Bognor (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") require to purchase and take the lands described in the schedule hereto for the purpose of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving the streets called London Road Chichester Road and Gordon Avenue in their District:

. 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say:—

Compulsory powers of purchase. Art. I. The Council shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands described in the schedule hereto subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway (if any) and for the purposes aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

Short title.

Art. II. This Order may be cited as the Bognor Order 1920.

Provisional Order to enable the Urban Sanitary Authority for the City of Bradford to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

Bradford Order(1).

To the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Bradford;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Bradford acting by the Council as the Urban Sanitary Authority for that City (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") require to purchase and take the lands described in the schedule hereto for the following purposes that is to say:—

- (1) The lands described in Part I. of the said schedule for the purpose of widening opening enlarging or otherwise 'improving the streets known as West Lane Thorp Garth Albion Road Shetcliffe Lane Bowling Back Lane Barkerend Road Kirkgate and Harrogate Road;
- (2) The lands described in Part II. of the said schedule for the purposes of street improvements connected with the Central Improvements authorised by Part III. of the Bradford Corporation Act 1913:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of 38 & 39 Vict. all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from c. 55. and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say:—

Art. I. The Corporation shall be empowered to put in force with Compulsory reference to the lands described in the schedule hereto subject to the purchase. continuance of existing public rights of highway (if any) and for the purposes aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

Art. II. This Order may be cited as the Bradford Order (No. 1) Short title. 1920.

ROCHESTER AND CHATHAM JOINT SEWERAGE DISTRICT.

Provisional Order to enable the Rochester and Chatham Joint Sewerage Board to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

Rochesterand Chatham Order.

To the Rochester and Chatham Joint Sewerage Board;— And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Rochester and Chatham Joint Sewerage Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Joint Sewerage Board") require to purchase and take the lands described in the schedule hereto for purposes connected with the sewerage and disposal of the sewage of the Rochester and Chatham Joint Sewerage District and for providing access to the said lands:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of 38 & 39 Vict. all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that from c. 55. and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say:—

Art I. The Joint Sewerage Board shall be empowered to put Compulsory in force with reference to the lands described in the schedule hereto powers of subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway (if any) and for the purposes aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them:

A.D. 1920. Provided that the prescribed period for the compulsory purchase of the lands described in the schedule hereto shall for the purposes of Section 123 of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1845 be four years from the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order.

Short title. Art. II. This Order may be cited as the Rochester and Chatham Order 1920.
