CHAPTER xxix.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the A.D. 1924.

Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act

1899 relating to Clydebank and District Water.

[14th July 1924.]

WHEREAS His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland has made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 and 62 & 63 it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed Vict. c. 47. by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

SCHEDULE.

CLYDEBANK AND DISTRICT WATER.

Provisional Order to extend the time for the completion of certain of the works authorised by the Clydebank and District Water Order 1910 to authorise the Clydebank and District Water Trustees to borrow additional money and for other purposes.

WHEREAS by the Clydebank and District Water and Burgh Extension Order 1906 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1906") the Clydebank and District Water Trustees (in this Order referred to as "the Trustees") were incorporated for the purpose of supplying water within the burgh of Clydebank and the district defined in the said Order and were authorised to acquire lands and to construct the works described in the said Order:

And whereas by the Clydebank and District Water Order 1909 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1909") and the Clydebank and District Water Order 1910 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1910") the Trustees were amongst other things authorised and required to abandon certain of the works and portions of the works authorised by the Order of 1906 and were authorised to construct additional works and to apply to the purposes of the Order of 1909 and the Order of 1910 the borrowing powers conferred upon the Trustees by the Order of 1906:

And whereas by the Clydebank and District Water Order 1914 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1914") the period limited by the Order of 1910 for the completion of Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 thereby authorised was extended until the third day of August one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four:

And whereas it is expedient that the said period should be further extended as by this Order provided:

And whereas the Trustees were by the Order of 1906 authorised to borrow the sum of two hundred thousand pounds for their water undertaking (which borrowing

power was by the Order of 1909 and the Order of 1910 A.D. 1924. made applicable as aforesaid) and by the Order of 1914 the further sum of ninety thousand pounds for the waterworks in that Order specified making together the sum of two hundred and ninety thousand pounds:

And whereas the actual cost of the works authorised by the Order of 1906 the Order of 1909 and the Order of 1910 (other than the works abandoned as aforesaid and Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 which works have not been constructed) has exceeded the estimated cost thereof and the Trustees have borrowed and expended in connection with the construction of the said works (other than the said abandoned works and Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5) and for the general purposes of their undertaking the sum of two hundred and eighty thousand three hundred and ninety-seven pounds three shillings and sixpence which includes a sum of forty thousand five hundred pounds authorised to be borrowed in respect of the said Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 and a sum of twelve thousand four hundred and thirty pounds authorised to be borrowed for the covering over of Kilbowie Reservoir and for additional service tank accommodation making together the sum of fifty-two thousand nine hundred and thirty pounds:

And whereas it is expedient that the application by the Trustees of the said sum of fifty-two thousand nine hundred and thirty pounds to the purposes of their undertaking other than the purposes for which the said sums were authorised to be borrowed should be sanctioned and confirmed:

And whereas the present estimated cost of (1) the Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 (2) the covering over of Kilbowie Reservoir and (3) the additional service tank accommodation necessary for the purposes of the undertaking of the Trustees amounts to the sum of ninety-six thousand pounds and it is expedient that the Trustees should be authorised to borrow the said sum of ninety-six thousand pounds and also to borrow a further sum of forty-six thousand pounds for the purposes of their water undertaking as hereinafter in this Order provided:

And whereas it is expedient that the other powers in this Order contained should be conferred on the Trustees:

And whereas the purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order of the Secretary for Scotland confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899:

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last-mentioned Act the Secretary for Scotland orders as follows:—

Short and collective titles.

1. This Order may be cited for all purposes as the Clydebank and District Water Order 1924 and may together with the Order of 1906 the Order of 1909 the Order of 1910 and the Order of 1914 be cited as the Clydebank and District Water Orders 1906 to 1924.

Commencement of Order. 2. This Order shall commence and have effect on and from the date of the passing of the Act confirming the same which date is hereinafter referred to as "the commencement of this Order."

Extension of time for completion of works.

3. The period limited by the Order of 1910 as extended by the Order of 1914 for the completion of the Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 is hereby further extended for a period of ten years from the third day of August one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four and on the expiration of the said extended period the powers granted by the Order of 1910 for making and completing the said Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 shall cease except as to so much thereof as shall then be completed.

Additional borrowing powers &c.

- 4.—(1) The application by the Trustees of the moneys authorised to be borrowed for the purposes of Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 for the covering over of Kilbowie Reservoir and for additional service tank accommodation to the purposes of the undertaking of the Trustees other than the purposes for which the said moneys were authorised to be borrowed is hereby sanctioned and confirmed Provided that the moneys borrowed and applied by the Trustees as aforesaid shall be repaid within thirty years from the date or dates of borrowing the same.
- (2) In addition to any money which the Trustees have borrowed or are authorised to borrow under the Order of 1906 and the Order of 1914 the Trustees may

from time to time borrow by way of mortgage or other- A.D. 1924. wise any sums not exceeding the following sums namely:—

- (a) For the construction of Works No. 3 No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 the sum of seventy-six thousand pounds;
- (b) For the covering over of Kilbowie Reservoir for additional service tank accommodation for renewals of pipe lines and for additional supply and distributing pipes the sum of sixty-six thousand pounds;
- (c) For paying the costs charges and expenses of and in relation to this Order and the confirmation of the same such sum as may be necessary for that purpose;
- (d) For the purposes of the undertaking of the Trustees with the consent of the Secretary for Scotland but not otherwise such further moneys as the Trustees may require and the Secretary for Scotland shall have and may exercise in relation to such consent as aforesaid all the powers of section 93 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1889.
- 5. The estimate required to be made and the Estimate assessment and rates rents and charges authorised and &c. by required to be levied by the Trustees under and for the Trustees to purposes of the Order of 1906 the Order of 1909 the Order of 1910 and the Order of 1914 shall be made and levied so that the same shall include and be sufficient with the other revenues of the Trustees not only for the purposes specified in the said Orders of 1906 1909 1910 and 1914 but also for the purposes of this Order.

- A.D. 1924. money to be borrowed under this Order shall be as follows (that is to say):—
 - (1) As to money borrowed for the covering over of Kilbowie Reservoir and for additional service tank accommodation within fifty years from the date or dates of borrowing the same;
 - (2) As to money borrowed for Work No. 3 authorised by the Order of 1910 within forty years from the date or dates of borrowing the same;
 - (3) As to money borrowed for Works No. 4 and No. 5 authorised by the Order of 1910 for renewals of pipe lines and for additional supply and distributing pipes within thirty years from the date or dates of borrowing the same;
 - (4) As to moneys borrowed for the purpose of paying the costs charges and expenses of this Order as aforesaid within five years from the commence-sement of this Order;
 - (5) As to moneys borrowed with the approval of the Secretary for Scotland within such period and by such method as the Secretary for Scotland may notwithstanding anything in the Burgh Police (Scotland) Acts 1892 to 1911 contained prescribe.

Costs of Order.

7. All the costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing for obtaining and confirming this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Trustees out of the rates to be levied by them or other revenue of the Trustees or from moneys borrowed and to be borrowed on the security of the same.
