



CHAPTER lxxx.

An Act to extend the time for the completion of works under the Post Office (London) Railway Act 1913. A.D. 1924.

[7th August 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The time allowed for the completion of the railway and works authorised by the Post Office (London) Railway Act 1913 shall be fourteen years from the passing of that Act and accordingly that Act shall have effect as if in section thirty-seven thereof for the words "five years" there were substituted the words "fourteen years." 2. This Act may be cited as the Post Office (London) Railway Act 1924 and the Post Office (London) Railway Act 1913 and this Act may be cited together as the Post Office (London) Railway Acts 1913 and 1924. Short and
