



### CHAPTER lxxxi.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Brighton Doncaster Doncaster and Tickhill Joint Water District Northumberland and Sheffield. A.D. 1924.

[7th August 1924.]

**W**HEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Local Government Act 1888: 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament: 51 & 52 Vict. c. 41.

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 9) Act 1924. Short title.

BOROUGH OF BRIGHTON.

*Provisional Order to enable the Brighton Corporation  
to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands  
Clauses Acts.*

WHEREAS the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Brighton (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") acting by the Council as the local authority for that Borough for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of (a) widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving certain streets (b) making a new street and (c) providing an open market and buildings and conveniences in connection therewith and approaches thereto :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other Statutes in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say :—

Compulsory  
powers of  
purchase.

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule hereto (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

Short title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Brighton Order 1924.

WHEREAS the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Sheffield (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") acting by the Council as the local authority for that City for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of (a) making new streets (b) widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving certain streets and (c) for providing a public pleasure ground within the City :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other Statutes in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say :—

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule hereto (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them Provided that nothing herein shall empower the Corporation without the consent in writing of the Postmaster-General to enter upon or purchase or take the interest of the Postmaster-General in the properties numbered 817 and 818 on the plan referred to in the Schedule hereto.

Provided also that nothing herein contained shall empower the Corporation without the consent in writing of the London and North Eastern Railway Company to enter upon purchase or take the interest of that Company in the property numbered 160 on the plan referred to in the Schedule hereto.
