CHAPTER cxxviii.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to Bournemouth. A.D. 1925.
[22nd December 1925.]

WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 : 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Order in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Bournemouth Order) Act 1925. Short title.

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SCHEDULE.

BOROUGH OF BOURNEMOUTH.

*Provisional Order to enable the Bournemouth Corporation
to put in force the Compulsory Clauses of the Lands
Clauses Acts.*

WHEREAS the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bournemouth (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") acting by the Council as the local authority for that Borough for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving certain streets in the said Borough :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other Statutes in that behalf hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say :—

*Compulsory
powers of
purchase.*

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule hereto (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

Short title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Bournemouth (Compulsory Purchase of Lands) Order 1925.
