



CHAPTER xi.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to Acton and Ealing. A.D. 1928.
[10th May 1928.]

WHEREAS the Minister of Health has made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Metropolis Water Act 1902: 2 Edw. 7. c. 41.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Order in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (No. 2) Act 1928. Short title.

BOROUGHES OF ACTON AND EALING.

*Provisional Order for altering the Metropolis
Water Act 1902.*

WHEREAS by virtue of paragraph (iii) of clause 9 of the Third Schedule to the Metropolis Water Act 1902 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1902") the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Acton acting by the Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Acton Corporation") and the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Ealing acting by the Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Ealing Corporation") each appoint three members to represent them on the joint committee formed by the Boroughs of Acton and Ealing and the Urban District of Brentford and Chiswick for the purpose of appointing a member of the Metropolitan Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board");

And whereas by Section 26 of the Act of 1902 the Minister of Health is empowered by Provisional Order to alter the representation on the Board of any borough or urban district where it is proved to his satisfaction that by reason of the variation of population such alteration should be made;

And whereas by an Order dated the Ninth day of January One thousand nine hundred and three and made by the Local Government Board in pursuance of clause 11 of the said Schedule to the Act of 1902 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1903") regulations were made with reference to the constitution and proceedings of joint committees formed in pursuance of the Act of 1902;

And whereas the Acton Corporation and the Ealing Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order to alter the Act of 1902 in manner hereinafter appearing:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 26 of the Act of 1902 and Section 297 of the Public Health Act 1875 hereby orders that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this

Provisional Order Confirmation (No. 2) Act, 1928.

Order the Act of 1902 shall be altered and amended so that the following provisions shall take effect (that is to say) :—

1. The Act of 1902 shall have effect as if the following paragraph were substituted for paragraph (iii) of clause 9 of the Third Schedule thereto (that is to say) :—

“(iii) The joint committee of the councils of the boroughs of Acton and Ealing and the urban district of Brentford and Chiswick shall consist of sixteen members of whom six shall be appointed by the council of the borough of Ealing and five by each of the other councils.”

2. The provisions of Article 5 of the Order of 1903 shall apply to the first election of each additional member appointed by the Corporations of Acton and Ealing to represent them on the said joint committee in pursuance of this Order as if the election related to the filling of a vacancy occurring on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order.

3. This Order may be cited as the Acton and Ealing Order 1928.
