



CHAPTER xxxiii.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the
Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act
1899 relating to the London and North Eastern
Railway. [10th May 1929.]

WHEREAS the Provisional Order set forth in the
schedule hereunto annexed has been made by one
of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State under the
provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland)
Act 1899 as read with the Secretaries of State Act
1926 and it is requisite that the said Order should be
confirmed by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the
Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this
present Parliament assembled and by the authority of
the same as follows :—

1. The Provisional Order contained in the schedule
hereunto annexed shall be and the same is hereby
confirmed.

SCHEDULE.

LONDON AND NORTH EASTERN RAILWAY.

Provisional Order to confer further powers upon the London and North Eastern Railway Company.

WHEREAS it is expedient that further powers should be conferred upon the London and North Eastern Railway Company (in this Order referred to as "the Company") in regard to the acquisition retention use and sale or disposal of lands and that the other powers in this Order mentioned should be conferred:

And whereas the purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899:

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last mentioned Act as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926 the Secretary of State orders as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Order may be cited for all purposes as the London and North Eastern Railway Order 1929.

Extension
of power to

2. The Company may from time to time in addition to the lands authorised to be compulsorily taken by them for the purposes of the several Acts and Orders from time to time relating to their undertaking contract with any party willing to sell the same for the purchase of any lands for any of the purposes stated in section 38 of the Railways Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845 and may hold the same and any lands which the Company have already acquired for any of the said purposes.

For the purposes of this section the expression "the Company" means and includes in addition to the Company any joint committee now or hereafter incorporated or constituted by Act of Parliament on which the Company may be represented and as regards any undertaking now or hereafter belonging to the Company jointly with any other company or companies means and includes the Company and such other company or companies.

This section shall extend to Scotland only.

3. The provisions of section 43 (Power to Company and others to lease &c. lands) of the London and North Eastern Railway Act 1923 shall extend and apply to any lands or premises acquired or held or which may hereafter be acquired or held under the powers of the London and North Eastern Railway Order 1925 or this Order.

4. The provisions of section 8 (Powers as to building on or over lands) of the London and North Eastern Railway Order 1925 shall extend and apply to any lands or premises acquired or held or which may hereafter be acquired or held under the powers of this Order.

Application of s. 8 of Order of 1925.

5. The Company may appropriate and apply to all or any of the purposes or objects of this Order being purposes to which capital is properly applicable any of the moneys which they have raised or are authorised to raise and which may not be required for any purpose to which they are made specially applicable.

Power to Company to apply funds.

6. All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for obtaining and confirming of this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Company.
