



CHAPTER vii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Montgomery and Somerset. A.D. 1929.
—
[27th March 1929.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888 the Minister of Health has made certain Orders which are set out in the schedule hereto : 51 & 52 Vict.
c. 41.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 2) Act 1929. Short title.

COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY.

County of
Montgomery
Order.

*Provisional Order made in pursuance of subsection (2)
of section 69 of the Local Government Act 1888.*

WHEREAS the County Council of the Administrative County of Montgomery propose to borrow with the consent of the Minister of Health and subject to the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888 certain sums of money which if borrowed will together with the total debt of the County Council after deducting the amount of any sinking fund exceed the amount which the County Council are authorised to borrow under that Act;

And whereas the County Council have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to increase the amount which may be borrowed by them :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 69 of the said Act and of any other powers in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

Additional
borrowing

1. Subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888 the County Council of the Administrative County of Montgomery may from time to time borrow such sums as may be required not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of fifteen thousand pounds in excess of the limit imposed by the provisions of subsection (2) of section 69 of that Act.

2. This Order may be cited as the County of Montgomery Order 1929 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

COUNTY OF SOMERSET.

WHEREAS the County Council of the Administrative County of Somerset propose to borrow with the consent of the Minister of Health and subject to the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888 certain sums of money which if borrowed will together with the total debt of the County Council after deducting the amount of any sinking fund exceed the amount which the County Council are authorised to borrow under that Act;

And whereas the County Council have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to increase the amount which may be borrowed by them :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 69 of the said Act and of any other powers in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

1. Subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888 the County Council of the Administrative County of Somerset may from time to time borrow such sums as may be required not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of three hundred thousand pounds in excess of the limit imposed by the provisions of subsection (2) of section 69 of that Act. Additional borrowing powers.

2. This Order may be cited as the County of Somerset Order 1929 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it. Short title and commencement.
