

### CHAPTER clv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the Board A.D. 1912. of Trade under the Electric Lighting Acts 1882 to 1909 relating to certain burghs and parishes in the counties of Linlithgow Stirling and Dunbarton.

[13th December 1912.]

WHEREAS under the authority of the Electric Lighting 45 & 46 Vict.

Acts 1882 to 1909 the Board of Trade have made the c. 56. Provisional Order set out in the schedule to this Act:

51 & 52 Vict. c. 12. 53 & 54 Vict.

And whereas a Provisional Order made by the Board of Trade under the authority of the said Acts is not of any validity <sup>2</sup> Edw. <sup>7</sup>. or force whatever until the confirmation thereof by Act of 9 Edw. 7. Parliament:

And whereas it is expedient that the Provisional Order made by the Board of Trade under the authority of the said Acts as set out in the schedule to this Act be confirmed by Act of Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Electric Lighting Order Short title. Confirmation (No. 4) Act 1912.
- 2. The Order as amended and set out in the schedule to Order in this Act is hereby confirmed and the same shall from and after schedule the passing and subject to the provisions of this Act have full validity and effect.

For protection of county councils of Linlithgow Stirling and Dunbarton and others.

3. The said Order shall have effect as if sections 54 and 58 of the Scottish Central Electric Power Act 1903 which make provision for the protection of county authorities as therein defined and the provost magistrates and councillors of the burgh of Falkirk and the Falkirk and Larbert Water Trustees were incorporated with the said Order and as if in those sections as so incorporated the Undertaker under the said Order was substituted for "the Company" (that is to say for the Scottish Central Electric Power Company).

## AND FALKIRK DISTRICT ELECTRIC LIGHTING.

Linlithgowand Falkirk.

Provisional Order granted by the Board of Trade under the Electric Lighting Acts 1882 to 1909 to George Balfour in respect to certain burghs and parishes in the counties of Linlithgow Stirling and Dunbarton.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Linlithgow and Falkirk Short title. District Electric Lighting Order 1912.
- 2. The provisions contained in the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 (with the exception of section 84 of that schedule) Lighting are incorporated with and form part of this Order.

Incorporation of Electric (Clauses) Act 1899.

3. The Undertaker for the purposes of this Order and within the Undertaker. meaning of section 2 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 is George Balfour of 22A College Hill Cannon Street in the city of London electrical engineer.

4. The area of supply for the purposes of this Order and within Area of the meaning of section 4 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting supply. (Clauses) Act 1899 shall be the area which is described in the First Schedule to this Order and is more particularly delineated on the map deposited together with this Order at the Board of Trade by the Undertaker and signed by an assistant secretary to the Board of Trade.

5. Subject to the provisions incorporated with this Order the Power to Undertaker is specially authorised by this Order to break up the streets break up streets &c. not repairable by the local authority which are mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Order and the railways and tramways which are also mentioned in that schedule.

6. The parts of streets throughout which suitable and sufficient Compulsory distributing mains for the purposes of general supply are to be laid works. down within a period of two years after the commencement of this Order as mentioned in section 21 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 are those mentioned in the Third Schedule to this Order.

7. The maximum prices which may be charged by the Undertaker Maximum as mentioned in section 32 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting prices. . (Clauses) Act 1899 are those stated in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.

A.D. 1912. Linlithgow and Falkirk. Deposit.

8. The sum to be deposited or secured in pursuance of section 5 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 is six hundred pounds (that is to say) one hundred pounds in respect of the burgh of Linlithgow one hundred pounds in respect of the burgh of Bathgate one hundred pounds in respect of the burgh of Armadale and three hundred pounds in respect of the parishes mentioned in the First Schedule to this Order.

Number of entitled to tion.

9. Section 24 of the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 as incorporated with this Order shall have effect as if in make requisi- that section three were substituted for six as the minimum number of owners or occupiers by whom a requisition under that section may be made.

Power to revoke Order where no mains are laid.

- 10.—(1) If at the expiration of three years from the commencement of this Order distributing mains shall not have been laid down in the parishes mentioned in the First Schedule to this Order and forming part of the said area of supply (other than the parish of Larbert mentioned in the Third Schedule to this Order) the Board of Trade may if they think fit revoke this Order in respect of any of the said parishes where such mains shall not have been laid.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed as affecting the power of the Board of Trade to revoke this Order under the provisions contained in the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899.

For protection of Commissioners of Works.

11. The Undertaker shall not except with the approval of the Commissioners of Works erect any generating station within a distance of half a mile from the Royal Park of Linlithgow unless the site for such generating station is specified in an Act of Parliament or in an Order confirmed by or having the effect of an Act of Parliament Provided always that this section shall not apply to any substation for the transformation and distribution of electrical power Provided also that this section shall not apply to any station which may be in existence and which shall not be extended beyond the limits of the site occupied by the buildings of such station at the passing of the Act confirming this Order.

Transfer of undertaking.

- 12.—(1) The powers given by this Order shall not be exercised unless within twelve months or such extended period not exceeding in the whole fifteen months as the Board of Trade allow after the passing of the Act confirming this Order the Undertaker transfers the undertaking to a limited company registered under the Companies (Consolidation) Act 1908 and approved by the Board of Trade for the purpose.
- (2) Within that period the Undertaker may transfer and the. company to whom the transfer is to be made may take a transfer of

the undertaking with the consent of and on such terms and conditions A.D. 1912. as may be approved by the Board of Trade by deed approved by Linlithgow that Board.

- (3) On such transfer the rights powers authorities obligations and liabilities of the Undertaker in respect to the undertaking shall be transferred to and may be exercised by and shall attach to the company to whom the transfer is made and that company shall subject to the provisions of this Order become the Undertakers for the purposes of this Order.
- (4) If the transfer has not been made before the expiration of the period limited in that behalf in this section the Board of Trade may revoke this Order upon the expiration of that period.
- 13. After the said transfer and when the company to whom the Purchase same has been made have become the Undertakers for the purposes of this Order the following provisions shall have effect:—

by county councils.

- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in section 2 of the Electric Lighting Act 1888 the local authority (being a county council) may within six months after the expiration. of any of the periods mentioned in that section by notice require the Undertakers to sell and thereupon the Undertakers shall sell to them so much of the undertaking as is situate within any special lighting district formed or to be formed under the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1894 within the jurisdiction of the local authority upon terms of paying the then value of all lands buildings works material and plant of the Undertakers suitable to and used by them for the purposes of the undertaking within such district such value to be determined upon the basis and in manner prescribed by the said section 2 of the Electric Lighting Act 1888 in the case of a purchase by a local authority under that section and upon any such purchase all lands buildings works material and plant so purchased as aforesaid shall vest in the local authority freed from any debts mortgages or similar obligations of the Undertakers or attaching to the undertaking and the powers of the Undertakers in relation to the supply of electricity under this Order within such district shall absolutely cease and determine and shall vest in the local authority:
  - (2) Before entering upon any arbitration under the preceding subsection of this section it shall be determined by agreement between the local authority and the Undertakers and failing agreement by arbitration what lands buildings works material and plant are suitable to and used by them for the purposes of so much of the undertaking as is situate

within the special lighting district in respect of which notice has been given under the preceding subsection and if the local authority are dissatisfied with the determination of the arbiter under this subsection they shall for a period of one month after such determination be at liberty to withdraw their said notice. Provided that in the event of such withdrawal the local authority shall pay to the Undertakers the reasonable costs incurred by them in respect of any such arbitration:

(3) The power of purchase conferred by this section is in addition to and not in derogation of the power of purchase conferred by section 2 of the Electric Lighting Act 1888.

Purchase by town council of Bathgate. 14. Section 2 of the Electric Lighting Act 1888 shall apply to so much of the undertaking as is situate within the municipal burgh of Bathgate as if for the periods of forty-two years and ten years mentioned in that section the periods of thirty years and five years were therein mentioned.

Commencement of Order. 15. Except for the purpose of enabling the said transfer to be made this Order shall not come into force notwithstanding the confirmation thereof by Parliament until the day when the transfer takes effect and that day for the purposes of the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 shall be the commencement of this Order.

### THIRD SCHEDULE.

Parts of streets throughout which suitable and sufficient distributing mains for the purposes of general supply are to be laid down within a period of two years after the commencement of this Order.

#### FOURTH SCHEDULE.

#### MAXIMUM PRICES.

In this schedule—

The expression "unit" shall mean the energy contained in a current of one thousand ampères flowing under an electro-motive force of one volt during one hour.

#### SECTION 1.

Where the Undertaker charges any consumer by the actual amount of energy supplied to him he shall be entitled to charge him at the following rates per quarter:—

- (1) In the case of a supply to the local authority or any public lighting authority and in the case of a supply to any consumer for power purposes—
  - (a) For any quantity not exceeding the equivalent of four hundred hours of supply at the maximum power which has been demanded by the consumer at the rate of threepence per unit;

(b) For any further quantity exceeding the equivalent A.D. 1912. of four hundred hours of supply at such maximum power at the rate of twopence per unit:

Linlithgow and Falkirk.

The prices so charged under this subsection shall include the cost of transforming the energy if so required by the authority or person supplied to such pressure and in the case of a supply in bulk to a local authority or to any public lighting authority to such description of current as the authority or person respectively may reasonably require:

(2) In the case of a supply to any consumer other than a local authority or public lighting authority for any other purpose for any amount up to twenty units ten shillings and for each unit over twenty units sixpence.

#### Section 2.

Where the Undertaker charges any consumer by the electrical quantity contained in the supply given to him he shall be entitled to charge such consumer according to the rates set forth in section 1 of this schedule the amount of energy supplied to such consumer being taken to be the product of that electrical quantity and the declared pressure at the consumer's terminals that is to say such a constant pressure at those terminals as may be declared by the Undertaker under the Board of Trade regulations.
