



CHAPTER xix.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 relating to Lanarkshire Renfrewshire and Dunbartonshire Education Authorities. A.D. 1929.

[26th July 1929.]

WHEREAS the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed has after inquiry held before Commissioners been made by one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926 and it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Provisional Order contained in the schedule hereunto annexed shall be and the same is hereby confirmed.

SCHEDULE.

LANARKSHIRE RENFREWSHIRE AND DUN-
BARTONSHIRE EDUCATION AUTHORITIES.

*Provisional Order to make the provisions of the Local
Government (Adjustments) (Scotland) Act 1914
applicable to section 62 of the Glasgow Boundaries
Act 1925.*

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of the Education (Scotland) Act 1918 education authorities were constituted for the counties of Lanark Renfrew and Dunbarton respectively (hereinafter referred to as "the Education Authorities") and an education authority was constituted for the burgh of the city of Glasgow as existing at the passing of that Act :

And whereas by the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 certain areas in the counties of Lanark Renfrew and Dunbarton were added to the city of Glasgow and by section 62 of that Act it was provided inter alia that the city as extended by that Act should form an education area under the provisions of the Education (Scotland) Act 1918 in the same way and to the same effect as if the city as extended formed the burgh of Glasgow mentioned in that Act and that the said areas added to the city of Glasgow should cease to form part of the education areas of the counties of Lanark Renfrew and Dunbarton respectively and should for the purposes of the Education (Scotland) Acts 1872 to 1924 be added to the then existing electoral divisions of the education area for the said city of Glasgow :

And whereas in the year one thousand nine hundred and fourteen the Local Government (Adjustments) (Scotland) Act 1914 was passed being an Act to amend the law relating to the adjustment of financial relations between local government areas in Scotland on the alteration of the boundaries thereof and by that Act the principle upon which such adjustment was to be made was laid down :

And whereas under the said Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 provision was made that the financial adjustments as between the corporation and the county councils and district committees or any of them consequent upon the annexation of the added area to the then existing city of Glasgow should be made upon the basis of the provisions of the said Local Government (Adjustments) (Scotland) Act 1914 and in accordance with the rules contained in the schedule to that Act : A.D. 1929.

And whereas it was contemplated and it is just and equitable that under section 62 of the said Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 the Education Authorities should similarly be entitled to make financial adjustments as between themselves and the education authority of the city of Glasgow upon the basis of the provisions of the said Local Government (Adjustments) (Scotland) Act 1914 :

And whereas the Education Authorities having applied to the Secretary of State to give effect by orders to claims for financial adjustments as aforesaid have been informed that the Secretary of State has no power under section 62 of the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 to give effect thereto and it is expedient to amend the provisions of the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 in this and other respects :

And whereas the purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an order confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 :

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last-mentioned Act as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926 the Secretary of State orders as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited for all purposes as the *Lanarkshire Renfrewshire and Dunbartonshire Education Authorities Order 1929.* Short title

2. In this Order (unless there be something in the subject or context repugnant to such construction) the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them (that is to say) :— Interpreta-

The expression “ the Education Authorities ” means

Lanark Renfrew and Dunbarton respectively as constituted by the Education (Scotland) Act 1918;

The expression "the city" means the city of Glasgow;

The expression "the Glasgow Education Authority" means the education authority of the city.

3.—(1) Section 62 of the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 shall be read and have effect as though among the matters which the Secretary of State is thereby directed to make provision for by order there were included financial adjustments as between the Education Authorities or any of them and the Glasgow Education Authority consequent upon the alteration of boundaries effected by the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1925 and as though the said financial adjustments were directed to be made upon the basis of the provisions of the Local Government (Adjustments) (Scotland) Act 1914 and in accordance with the rules contained in the schedule to that Act.

(2) In determining the sum (if any) to be paid by the Glasgow Education Authority in respect of the said financial adjustments the costs of this Order shall be taken into consideration.

Costs of
Order.

4. All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for obtaining and confirming of this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Education Authorities.
