



## CHAPTER ii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Gillingham and Sunderland. A.D. 1929.  
[26th July 1929.]

**W**HEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made certain Orders which are set out in the schedule hereto: 38 & 39 Vict. c. 55.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 7) Act 1929. Short title.

SCHEDULE.

BOROUGH OF GILLINGHAM.

*Gillingham Order.* *Provisional Order to enable the Gillingham Corporation to put in force the compulsory clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.*

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the Borough of Gillingham acting by the council (in this Order referred to as "the Corporation") require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule to this Order for the purposes of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving the streets known as Canterbury Street and Copenhagen Road in the Borough of Gillingham:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Compulsory powers of purchase.

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule to this Order (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

Short title and commencement.

2. This Order may be cited as the Gillingham Order 1929 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the Borough of Sunderland acting by the council (in this Order referred to as "the Corporation") require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule to this Order for the purpose of extending Mere Knolls Cemetery in the Borough of Sunderland :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—
