



CHAPTER xxx.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Brighton Halifax and Upton upon Severn.

A.D. 1929.

[6th December 1929.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made certain Orders which as amended are set out in the schedule hereto :

38 & 39 Vict.
c. 55.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Orders as amended and set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force.

*Provisional Order to enable the Brighton Corporation to
put in force the compulsory clauses of the Lands
Clauses Acts.*

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the Borough of Brighton acting by the council (in this Order referred to as "the Corporation") require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule to this Order for the purposes of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving certain streets in the Borough of Brighton :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

1. The Corporation shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule to this Order (subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. This Order may be cited as the Brighton Order 1929 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Provisional Order to enable the Rural District Council of Upton upon Severn to put in force the compulsory clauses of the Lands Clauses Acts.

WHEREAS the Rural District Council of Upton upon Severn (in this Order referred to as "the Council") require to purchase and take the lands described in the Schedule to this Order for the purposes of the maintenance and provision of sewage outfall and disposal works:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Compulsory

1. The Council shall be empowered for the purposes aforesaid to put in force with reference to the lands described in the Schedule to this Order (subject to the continuance of any existing public rights of highway if any) the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts as modified by the Acquisition of Land (Assessmen

of Compensation) Act 1919 with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

2. Subject to the provisions of section 56 of the Local Government Act 1929 the reasonable costs incurred by the Council in respect of this Order shall be defrayed as special expenses on the contributory place of Hanley Castle.

3. This Order may be cited as the Upton upon Severn Order 1929 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.
