



CHAPTER 1.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Minister of Health relating to Barry and Scarborough. A.D. 1930.
—
[15th April 1930.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made certain provisional orders which need confirmation by Parliament: 38 & 39 Vict.
c. 55.

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders of the Minister of Health which as amended are set out in the schedule to this Act are hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. Orders in

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (Barry and Scarborough) Act 1930. Short title.

SCHEDULE.

URBAN DISTRICT OF BARRY.

Barry Order.

Provisional Order altering the Barry Order 1927.

WHEREAS the Urban District Council of Barry are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 for the urban district of Barry;

And whereas under the provisions of the Barry and Cadoxton Local Board (Gas and Water) Act 1893 the Barry Urban District Council Act 1896 and the Barry Urban District Council Act 1913 the Council carry on a water undertaking and supply water within their district and certain other areas;

And whereas by the Barry Order 1927 which was confirmed by the Ministry of Health Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 10) Act 1927 the Council were authorised to construct certain additional works for the purposes of their water undertaking;

And whereas the Council have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to alter or amend the Barry Order 1927 in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 297 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short titles and commencement.

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Barry Order 1930 and this order and the Barry Order 1927 may be cited together as the Barry Orders 1927 and 1930.

(2) This order shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation.

2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Council” means the Urban District Council of Barry;

“the former Work No. 1” and “the former Work No. 2” mean respectively Work No. 1 and Work No. 2 authorised by article 3 of the order of 1927;

“the order of 1927” means the Barry Order 1927;

“the ordnance map” means the ordnance map of Glamorgan (edition of 1919) on the scale of 1/2500;

“the plans and sections deposited for this order” means the plans and sections which were deposited in the office of the Minister of Health on the eighth day of July nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and of which duplicates were on the same day deposited in the office of the Clerk of Parliaments House of Lords and in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons.

3. Subject to the provisions of this order the Council may in the lines and situation and upon the lands delineated and according to the levels shown on the plans and sections deposited for this order construct and maintain the following works that is to say :—

Work No. 1 An aqueduct conduit line or lines of pipes (being a diversion in part of the former Work No. 1) situate wholly in the parish of Llantwit Fardre in the rural district of Llantrisant and Llantwit Fardre commencing by a junction with the former Work No. 1 at a point in Station Road opposite the south-west corner of the land numbered 847 on the ordnance map sheet XXXVI. 7 and terminating in that road by a junction with the former Work No. 1 at a point 30 yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the centre of the bridge belonging to the Great Western Railway Company over the said Station Road :

Work No. 2 An aqueduct conduit line or lines of pipes (being another diversion in part of the former Work No. 1) situate wholly in the parish of Saint Fagans in the rural district of Cardiff commencing in the road leading to Saint Fagans bridge over the river Ely by a junction with the former Work No. 1 at a point 120 yards or thereabouts measured in a north-easterly direction along the said road from the north-west corner of the enclosure numbered 239 on the ordnance map sheet XLII. 12 and terminating by a junction with the former Work No. 1 in the road at the north-west corner of the land numbered 321 on the ordnance map sheet XLII. 16 :

Work No. 3 An aqueduct conduit line or lines of pipes commencing in the service reservoir authorised by article 2 of the order of 1927 in or on the land numbered 61a on the ordnance map sheet XLVI. 4 in the parish of Wenvoe in the rural district of Cardiff passing through the said parish of Wenvoe the parish of St. Andrews Major the urban district of Barry and the detached

part of the parish of Porthkerry and terminating by a junction with the existing line of pipes of the Council at the crossing of the roads known as the Port Road and Pontypridd Road in the said detached part of the parish of Porthkerry.

Modifica-
tion and
application
of order of
1927.

- 4.—(1) The order of 1927 shall be modified as follows :—
- (a) Work No. 1 by this order authorised shall be substituted for so much of the former Work No. 1 as lies between the points of commencement and termination of Work No. 1 by this order authorised ;
 - (b) Work No. 2 by this order authorised shall be substituted for so much of the former Work No. 1 as lies between the points of commencement and termination of Work No. 2 by this order authorised ;
 - (c) Work No. 3 by this order authorised shall be substituted for the former Work No. 2 ;
 - (d) References in the order of 1927 to the deposited plans and the deposited sections so far as those references relate to the works for which the works by this order authorised are substituted shall be read as references to the plans and sections deposited for this order ;
 - (e) References in the order of 1927 to Work No. 1 shall be read as references to that Work as altered by this order ;

and all the provisions of the order of 1927 shall apply and have effect accordingly as if the works authorised by this order were authorised by the order of 1927 :

Provided that paragraph (2) of article 11 of the order of 1927 shall cease to have effect and Work No. 2 by this order authorised shall cross the South Wales Railway of the Great Western Railway Company near Saint Fagan's Station by being laid at some point under the railway to be reasonably approved by the engineer of that company within the limits of deviation shown upon the plans and sections deposited for this order and in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of that article.

(2) Any part of the works by this order authorised which may have been constructed by the Council before the date upon which this order comes into operation shall be deemed to have been constructed in accordance with the provisions of the order of 1927.

BOROUGH OF SCARBOROUGH.

Provisional Order altering the Scarborough Corporation Act 1925. *Scarborough Order:*

WHEREAS the Borough of Scarborough is an urban district of which the mayor aldermen and burgesses acting by the council are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875;

And whereas the provisions of the Scarborough Corporation Act 1925 are in force in the borough and by section 18 of that Act the Corporation are empowered to lay out and develop any lands acquired by them within the limits of deviation for certain of the street works authorised by that Act and not required for the purposes for which they were acquired and to erect and maintain shops offices warehouses and other like buildings on any such lands and to sell lease exchange or otherwise dispose of any buildings so erected;

And whereas by section 36 of the local Act it is enacted that any premises used or proposed to be used for the preparation or manufacture of potted or preserved meat fish or other food intended for the purposes of sale shall be registered by the owner or occupier thereof with the Corporation and that no premises shall be used for those purposes unless the same are so registered;

And whereas the Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to alter or amend the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Scarborough Order 1930 and except as otherwise provided in this order shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it. *Short title and commencement.*

2. In this order—

“The Corporation” means the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Scarborough;

“The local Act” means the Scarborough Corporation Act 1925.

Interpretation.

3.—(1) In subsection (1) of section 18 of the local Act after the word “warehouses” wherever that word occurs the words “houses residences flats tenements” shall be inserted. *Extension of s. 18 of local Act to houses residences*

Registration of premises used for preparation or manufacture of ice-cream for sale.

(2) The purposes of section 18 of the local Act as extended by this article shall be deemed to be purposes of the local Act for which the Corporation with the consent of the Minister of Health may borrow money under subsection (3) of section 56 of that Act.

4.—(1) In subsection (1) of section 36 of the local Act after the words "manufacture of" the words "ice-cream or other similar commodity" shall be inserted.

(2) Public notice of the effect of the extension of section 36 of the local Act made by this article shall be given by the Corporation as soon as practicable after the passing of the Act for the confirmation of this order by advertisement in two newspapers published or circulating in the borough of Scarborough and by a notice affixed outside the town hall.

(3) Paragraph (1) of this article shall come into operation on the expiration of three weeks after public notice has been given in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2) of this article.
