



CHAPTER cxvii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders made by the Board of Education under the Education Acts 1870 to 1911 to enable the Councils of the Administrative Counties of Cardigan Carmarthen Cumberland Kent Merioneth Montgomery Pembroke and the West Riding of Yorkshire and the Urban District of Aberdare to put in force the Lands Clauses Acts. A.D. 1913.

[15th August 1913.]

WHEREAS the Board of Education have made certain Provisional Orders under the authority of the Education Acts 1870 to 1911 on behalf of the councils of the administrative counties of Cardigan Carmarthen Cumberland Kent Merioneth Montgomery Pembroke and the West Riding of Yorkshire and the urban district of Aberdare being the local education authorities under the Education Act 1902 for the said administrative counties and urban district and it is requisite that the same should be confirmed by Parliament:

And whereas the lands required to be purchased under the powers granted by the said Provisional Orders and confirmed by this Act are severally described in the schedules to the said Provisional Orders as set out in the schedule to this Act and are delineated on the plans accompanying the respective petitions referred to in the said Provisional Orders and copies of all the said plans have been duly deposited in the offices of the two Houses of Parliament:
