



CHAPTER cxxxiii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Government Board relating to Barnes Burnley Gelligaer Hendon Linthwaite and Pontardawe Rural. A.D. 1913.

[15th August 1913.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875:

38 & 39 Vict.
c. 55.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Orders in

WHEREAS the Urban District Council of Barnes (herein-after referred to as "the Council") require to purchase and take the lands described in the schedule hereto for the purpose of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving High Street Barnes :

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 and by any other Statutes in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect that is to say :—

Art. I. The Council shall be empowered to put in force with reference to the lands described in the schedule hereto subject to the continuance of existing public rights of highway (if any) and for the purpose aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

purposes of widening opening enlarging or otherwise improving the
following streets namely Church Street Saint James's Street Curzon
Street and Accrington Road and for the purpose of making a new
street from the street known as Kiddrow Lane to the street known
as Lowerhouse Lane:

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of
the powers given to Us by Section 176 of the Public Health Act 1875 38 & 39 Vict.
