



**CHAPTER xlvi.**

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Local Government Board relating to Birmingham. A.D. 1918.

[21st November 1918.]

**W**HEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the provisions of the Local Government Act 1888:

c. 41.

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force. Order in schedule confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board's Provisional Order Confirmation (No. 7) Act 1918. Short title.

CITY OF BIRMINGHAM.

*Birmingham Order.* *Provisional Order made in pursuance of Sections 59 and 87 of the Local Government Act 1888 for altering the Birmingham (Extension) Order 1911.*

To the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Birmingham ; —

And to all others whom it may concern.

*1 & 2 Geo. 5. c. xxxvi.* WHEREAS by virtue of the Birmingham (Extension) Order 1911 which was confirmed by the Local Government Board's Provisional Order (1910) Confirmation (No. 13) Act 1911 (which Order and Act are hereinafter respectively referred to as "the Order of 1911" and "the Confirming Act of 1911") the City of Birmingham (hereinafter referred to as "the City") is for the purposes of the election of Councillors divided into thirty wards and the Parish of Birmingham is for the purpose of the election of guardians divided into twenty-seven wards co-terminous with and bearing the same names as the municipal wards of the City comprised within the said Parish ;

And whereas it is proposed that further provision should be made with regard to the areas and boundaries of certain of the municipal wards of the City and with regard to the areas and boundaries of certain of the wards of the said Parish and the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City acting by the Council have made application to the Local Government Board for the issue of a Provisional Order to alter or amend the Order of 1911 in the manner hereinafter set forth :

*51 & 52 Vict. c. 41.* Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Sections 59 and 87 of the Local Government Act 1888 and by any other enactments in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act of Parliament confirming this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the commencement of this Order") the Order of 1911 and the Confirming Act of 1911 shall be altered so that the following provisions shall take effect that is to say:—

*Alteration of areas of wards of the City.* Art I. Subject to the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Act 1882 and the Acts amending and extending the same with respect to the alteration of wards the following provisions shall have effect that is to say:—

(1) Each of the wards of the City hereinafter mentioned that is to say the Acock's Green Ward the All Saints Ward the Aston

Ward the Balsall Heath Ward the Duddeston and Nechells  
Ward the Erdington South Ward the King's Norton Ward  
the Lozells Ward the Moseley and King's Heath Ward the  
Northfield Ward the St. Mary's Ward the St. Paul's Ward the  
Selly Oak Ward the Sparkbrook Ward the Sparkhill Ward  
and the Washwood Heath Ward shall be altered so as to  
comprise that part of the City which is indicated by a  
separate colour and distinguished by the name of the ward  
on the ward maps that is to say the two maps each marked  
"Map of the wards of the City of Birmingham as altered  
1918" and sealed with the official seal of the Local  
Government Board:

- (2) The Councillors who at the commencement of this Order represent the wards mentioned in the foregoing paragraph of this Article shall be deemed from and after that date to represent those wards respectively as altered by this Order.

Art. II. One of the ward maps shall be deposited in the office of the Local Government Board and the other shall be deposited by the town clerk of the City at his office within fourteen days after the date of this Order. Copies of the map deposited with the town clerk certified by him to be true shall be sent by him within one month after the commencement of this Order to the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries and to the Registrar-General.

Art. III. If any difficulty arises with respect to the preparation in the year One thousand nine hundred and eighteen of registers under the Representation of the People Act 1918 showing the names of the persons who are entitled to vote as local government electors at an election of councillors in any of the wards of the City altered by this Order the Local Government Board may make such order as appears to them to be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Order and may vary so far as is requisite the provisions in force with regard to the said registers.

Art. IV. Subject to the provisions of Section 60 of the Local Government Act 1894 and to the provisions of that Act as to the alteration of wards for the election of guardians of the poor the following provisions shall have effect that is to say:—

Alteration

- (1) The wards of the Parish of Birmingham which bear the names of the municipal wards of the City set out in subdivision (1) of Article I. of this Order shall be altered so that in each case the ward shall be co-terminous with the municipal ward bearing the same name as altered by this Order:
- (2) The persons who at the commencement of this Order are holding the office of Guardian of the Poor for the wards

of the Parish of Birmingham referred to in subdivision (1) of this Article shall be deemed from and after that date to have been elected for and shall represent those wards respectively as altered by this Order until the date on which they would have retired if this Order had not been made.

Short title.

Art. V. This Order may be cited as the Birmingham Order 1918.
