



**CHAPTER lxxiii.**

An Act to amend the enactments relating to the expenses of the Police Force of the City of London. A.D. 1919.

[15th August 1919.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The liability of the mayor and commonalty and citizens of the City of London to defray out of their revenue and possessions a fourth part of the expenses of the City Police Force shall cease and the limit on the rate which may be raised for the purposes of the expenses of that force shall be increased from eightpence to thirteenpence and accordingly the enactments mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Act shall have effect subject to the amendments set forth in the second column of that Schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the City of London Police Act 1919 and shall become operative as from the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and nineteen.

SCHEDULE.

Act.	Amendment.
City Police Act 1839	Section 57 shall be repealed. In section 58 for the words "remaining three equal fourth parts of the said expenses" there shall be substituted the words "expenses of the said Police Force" and for the words "eight pence" there shall be substituted the words "thirteen pence".
City of London Police Act 1874.	In section 4 the words "and proportion" shall be repealed.
