



## CHAPTER i.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under A.D. 1922,  
the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland)  
Act 1899 relating to Dundee High School.  
[15th December 1922.]

**W**HEREAS His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland  
has made the Provisional Order set forth in the  
schedule hereunto annexed under the provisions of the  
Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 and it 62 & 63 Vict.  
is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by c. 47.  
Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent  
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords  
Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present  
Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same  
as follows :—

1. The Provisional Order contained in the schedule  
hereunto annexed shall be and the same is hereby

2. This Act may be cited as the Dundee High School Order Confirmation Act 1922. (Session 2.) Short title.

DUNDEE HIGH SCHOOL.

*Provisional Order to authorise alterations in the scheme of representation on the Directorate of the Corporation of the High School of Dundee to provide for the future administration of the High School and for other purposes.*

WHEREAS the Corporation of the High School of Dundee (hereinafter called "the Corporation") was incorporated by Crown Charter dated the thirty-first day of October and written to the seal and sealed and registered the thirtieth day of November one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine with the powers and privileges in the said charter set forth :

And whereas by the William Harris Endowment and Dundee Education Act 1882 (hereinafter called "the Act of 1882") it was provided that the following persons should be directors of the Corporation the Provost of the Royal Burgh of Dundee the Dean of Guild of the Royal Burgh of Dundee the parish minister of Dundee for the time being the said parish minister being the minister of St. Mary's Established Church Dundee six persons to be elected by the town council of Dundee seven persons to be elected by the subscribers to the said Corporation three persons to be elected by the Dundee Chamber of Commerce one person to be elected by the Guildry Corporation of Dundee and one person to be elected by the Incorporation of the Nine Trades of Dundee all in manner therein mentioned and it was also provided that the management and direction of the affairs of the Corporation should be so conducted as to provide and secure as far as possible for the benefit of the inhabitants of Dundee and surrounding districts an institution for promoting a liberal education as extensive and complete as the funds of the Corporation might allow :

And whereas by section 9 (1) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1918 it is enacted that it shall be lawful for every education authority to contribute to the maintenance of any school not under their own manage-

ment which is included in the scheme for the provision of education within the education area of that authority approved by the Scottish Education Department and to make a reasonable representation of the education authority on the governing body of any such school a condition of any contribution made in terms thereof : A.D. 1922.

And whereas the Dundee Education Authority have agreed to contribute to the maintenance of the High School of Dundee as a school included in the scheme for the provision of education within the area of that Authority but have made it a condition of such contribution that they shall have representation on the High School Directorate as the governing body of the said school :

And whereas the Dundee Education Authority and the Corporation have agreed upon the extent of the said representation :

And whereas in order to give the representation so agreed upon without increasing the total number of directors of the Corporation it is expedient to reduce the number of directors elected annually by the town council of Dundee and the said town council have agreed to the number of their representatives being reduced accordingly :

And whereas it is expedient that the parish minister of Dundee for the time being the said parish minister being the minister of St. Mary's Established Church Dundee when permanently resident outwith the city of Dundee or when unable through infirmity to attend meetings should be represented by his "assistant and successor" at all meetings of the said High School directors :

And whereas the purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order of the Secretary for Scotland confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 :

Now therefore in virtue of the powers contained in the last mentioned Act the Secretary for Scotland orders as follows viz. :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Dundee High School Order 1922. Short title and citation of Acts.

This Order and the William Harris Endowment and Dundee Education Act 1882 may be cited as the Dundee High School Acts 1882 and 1922.

2. This Order shall come into operation at the date of the passing of the Act confirming the same.

Interpre-  
tation.

3. In this Order the following words and expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them unless there be something in the subject or context repugnant to such construction (that is to say) :—

“ The Education Authority ” means the Education Authority of the Burgh of Dundee constituted and elected under the Education (Scotland) Act 1918;

“ The Act of 1882 ” means the William Harris Endowment and Dundee Education Act 1882;

“ The Corporation ” means the Corporation of the High School of Dundee;

“ The High School ” means the High School of Dundee;

“ The Directors ” means the directors of the Corporation.

4. Section 5 (Directors after 1888) of the Act of 1882 is hereby amended in the following manner (that is to say) :—

The words “ one person ” shall be inserted therein in the place of the words “ six persons.”

The words “ five persons to be elected by the Education Authority ” shall be inserted therein after the word “ Council.”

The following words shall be inserted at the end of the said section “ It is hereby provided that if  
“ and when the Education Authority ceases to  
“ contribute to the High School under section 9  
“ (1) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1918 the  
“ persons elected by the Education Authority  
“ shall thereupon cease to be directors of the  
“ High School and the directors may thereupon  
“ if they think fit appoint as additional directors  
“ any person or persons not exceeding five in  
“ number who are not directors but whom the  
“ directors deem specially fitted to assist in the  
“ work of the High School any person so  
“ appointed holding office for such time as the  
“ directors may on his appointment determine.”

5. For the purpose of the election by the Education Authority of persons to be directors the Education Authority shall meet in the month of November and not later than the third Monday of that month in each year and shall elect the persons to be elected by the Education Authority to act as directors for the year ensuing such third Monday of November. The persons to be so elected or some of them may be persons other than members of the Education Authority.

6. When the parish minister being the minister of St. Mary's Established Church Dundee is permanently resident outwith the city of Dundee or when being resident within the city he is infirm and in consequence thereof he is unable to attend meetings of directors he shall be represented thereat by his assistant and successor who shall have power to take part in the business of the meeting and vote thereon in place and on behalf of the parish minister.

7. The Directors shall apply all heritable and moveable estate effects investments and funds in or coming to their hands for the purposes of carrying on the High School in accordance with the recited Royal Charter the Act of 1882 and this Order.

8. The costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing for obtaining and confirming this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the directors out of the funds under their charge.
