CHAPTER xiv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the
Minister of Health relating to the borough of
Newbury. [28th April 1939.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament : 38 & 39 Vict.
c. 55.

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. Order in

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Newbury) Act 1939. Short title.

SCHEDULE.

BOROUGH OF NEWBURY.

Provisional order altering a local Act and a provisional order.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Newbury acting by the council (in this order called "the corporation") carry on a water undertaking in pursuance of the Newbury Corporation Act 1925 and the Newbury (Water) Order 1929 which was confirmed by Parliament (in this order together called "the local Act and order") and supply water within the limits prescribed therein;

And whereas the corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to alter the local Act and order in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. This order may be cited as the Newbury Order 1939 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Extension
of water
limits of
corporation.

2. The limits of the corporation for the supply of water shall be extended so as to include the parish of Inkpen in the rural district of Hungerford in the county of Berks and the provisions of the local Act and order as to the supply of water and otherwise with respect to water purposes which now apply and have effect within the existing limits of the corporation for the supply of water shall (with any necessary modifications) apply and have effect within the limits of the corporation for the supply of water as extended by this order.
