

Tweed Fisheries Act 1857

1857 CHAPTER exlviii 20 and 21 Vict

XXVII Penalty on Officer taking Fees other than those allowed.

Every Officer employed by the Commissioners who shall exact or accept on account of anything done by virtue of his Office any Fee or Reward whatsoever other than the Salary or Allowances fixed by the Commissioners, or who shall be in any way concerned or interested in any Bargain or Contract made by the Commissioners, shall be liable to a Penalty of [FIFifty Pounds][FI level 3 on the standard scale], and shall be incapable of being aferwards employed by the Commissioners.
