



CHAPTER lxxix.

An Act to extend the time for the completion of the Railways authorised by the Cathcart District Railway Act, 1880. A.D. 1885.

[16th July 1885.]

WHEREAS by the Cathcart District Railway Act, 1880, the Cathcart District Railway Company (in this Act called “the Company”) were incorporated and authorised to make and maintain the railways in the said Act described : 43 & 44
Vict., c. 209..

And whereas the period limited by the said Act for the completion of the said railways expires on the seventh day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and the Company have been unable to complete the said railways, and it is expedient that their powers for that purpose should be extended :

And whereas the purposes of this Act cannot be effected without the authority of Parliament :

May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cathcart District Railway (Extension of Time) Act, 1885. Short title.

2. Part II. (relating to extension of time) of the Railways Clauses Act, 1863, is incorporated with and forms part of this Act. Incorporation

3. The time limited by the Cathcart District Railway Act, 1880, for the completion of the railways by that Act authorised, shall be and the same is hereby extended and enlarged until the expiration of two years from the seventh day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and if the said railways shall not be completed within the period so limited by this Act, then, on the expiration of such period, the powers by the said Act and this Act granted to the Company for making and completing the same, Extending

A.D. 1885. — or otherwise in relation thereto, shall cease to be exercised except as to so much thereof as shall then be completed.

Provision as
to general
railway
Acts.

4. Nothing in this Act shall exempt the Company or the said railways from the provisions of any general Act relating to railways, or the better and more impartial audit of the accounts of railway companies now in force, or which may hereafter pass during this or any future session of Parliament, or from any future revision or alteration under the authority of Parliament, of the maximum rates of fares and charges, or of the rates for small parcels authorised to be taken by the Company.

Costs of Act.

5. All costs, charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for, obtaining and passing of this Act, or otherwise in relation thereto, shall be paid by the Company.
