An Act to authorize the Purchase of a certain Ferry called “*Woodside Ferry*” by the Commissioners for the Improvement of the Township or Chapelry of *Birkenhead* in the County Palatine of *Chester*; and for amending the Improvement Acts for the said Township. [22d April 1842.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Third and Fourth Years of the Reign of His Majesty King *William* the Fourth, intituled *An Act for paving, lighting, watching, cleansing, and otherwise improving the Township or Chapelry of Birkenhead in the County Palatine of Chester, and for regulating the Police thereof, and for establishing a Market within the said Township*; and another Act was passed in the First and Second Years of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend an Act passed in the Third Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled ‘An Act for paving, lighting, watching, cleansing, and otherwise improving the Township or Chapelry of Birkenhead in* [Local.] *L the*
