



CHAPTER xii.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Local Government Board relating to the Local Government District of Panteg.
[25th September 1886.]

A.D. 1886.

WHEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto, under the provisions of the Public Health Act, 1875:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby confirmed, and all the provisions thereof shall, from and after the date therein mentioned, have full validity and force.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT OF PANTEG.

*Provisional Order for extending the Local Government District
of Panteg.*

To the Llanfrechfa Upper Local Board, being the Sanitary Authority for the Urban Sanitary District of Llanfrechfa Upper, in the County of Monmouth ; —

To the Panteg Local Board, being the Sanitary Authority for the Urban Sanitary District of Panteg, in the same County ; —

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Local Government District of Llanfrechfa Upper, in the County of Monmouth (herein-after called "the Llanfrechfa District"), is an Urban Sanitary District, of which the Llanfrechfa Upper Local Board are the Urban Sanitary Authority ;

And whereas the Local Government District of Panteg, in the same County (herein-after called "the Panteg District"), is an Urban Sanitary District, of which the Panteg Local Board are the Urban Sanitary Authority ;

And whereas the part of the Llanfrechfa District, herein-after described, immediately adjoins the Panteg District ;

And whereas the Llanfrechfa Upper Local Board have borrowed certain sums, amounting in the whole to the sum of one thousand three hundred and seventy pounds, for the construction of works of sewerage in the portion of their District which is hereby included in the Panteg District, of which the sum of one thousand and eighty-eight pounds five shillings and fivepence, or thereabouts, now remains unpaid :

Now, therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 270 of the Public Health Act, 1875, and by any other Statutes in that behalf, do hereby Declare that, from and after the commencement of this Order, all that part of the Llanfrechfa District which is isolated and detached from the remainder of that District, and is known as Griffith's Town, shall be included in, and form part of, the Panteg District.

And We hereby Order as follows ; viz., —

Art. I. This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-ninth day of September, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, herein referred to as "the commencement of this Order."

Art. II. The number of members to be elected for the Llanfrechfa District and the Panteg District respectively, as hereby altered, shall, subject to

the provisions of Rule 2 of Schedule II. to the Public Health Act, 1875, be the same as before the date of this Order. A.D. 1886.

Art. III. The liability for repayment of the said sum of one thousand and eighty-eight pounds five shillings and fivepence, or so much thereof as shall be owing at the commencement of this Order, shall pass to and vest in the Panteg Local Board, who shall from time to time make separate assessments, and levy and make such a rate or rates, in the nature of a General District Rate, upon the part of the Llanfrechfa District which, by operation of this Order, is included in the Panteg District, as shall be sufficient to defray, in the manner provided by the securities, the said sum of one thousand and eighty-eight pounds five shillings and fivepence, or so much thereof as shall be owing at the commencement of this Order, and the interest due or to become due thereon, within the respective periods for which the loans in respect of which the said sum is owing, were originally sanctioned.
