



CHAPTER ciii.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the A.D. 1890.
Education Department under the Elementary Education
Act, 1870, to enable the School Board for West Ham to
put in force the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845,
and the Acts amending the same. [25th July 1890.]

WHEREAS the Lords of the Committee of the Privy Council
on Education have made a Provisional Order under the
authority of the Elementary Education Act, 1870, on behalf of the 33 & 34 Vict.
School Board for West Ham, and it is requisite that the same should c. 75.
be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and
Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:

For the purposes of this section, the expression "labouring
class" includes mechanics, artizans, labourers, and others working
for wages, hawkers, costermongers, persons not working for wages
but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others
except members of their own family, and persons, other than
domestic servants, whose income does not exceed an average of
thirty shillings a week, and the families of any of such persons
who may be residing with them.

*Provisional Order for putting in force the Lands Clauses
Consolidation Act, 1845.*

At the Council Chamber, the 8th day of April 1890.

WHEREAS the School Board for the borough of West Ham, in the county of Essex, require to purchase certain pieces of land for the purposes of the Elementary Education Act, 1870, and not having been able to purchase the same by agreement, require to put in force the provisions of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, and the Acts amending the same, which apply to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement:

And whereas the lands so required to be purchased are set forth in the schedule hereunder written:

And whereas the said Board have made due publication of the notices, and have duly served the same, according to the requirements of the Elementary Education Act, 1870, and have presented a petition to the Education Department praying that an Order may be made authorising the said School Board to put in force the powers of the said Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement, in which petition were stated all the matters required by the said Elementary Education Act to be stated therein, and the same hath been supported by such evidence as the said Education Department required:

And whereas the said Department, having considered the said petition and the proofs of the publication and service of the proper notices, have thought fit to proceed with the case, and have caused inquiry to be made in the district of the said Board wherein the said lands are situate as to the propriety of the proposed Order:

Now, therefore, the said Department, having received a report after such inquiry, and having duly considered the same, do hereby declare that it is proper, and do hereby order accordingly, that the said Board be authorised to put in force, with reference to the pieces of land set forth in the schedule hereunder written, the powers of the said Acts for the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or any of them.

SCHEDULE to the foregoing Order.

A.D. 1890.

Borough of West Ham, county of Essex.

Bridge Road, Stratford, Site.

A.—Two dwelling-houses, and shop and dwelling-house on the east side of Bridge Road, Stratford, abutting west on Bridge Road aforesaid, and east on the premises immediately herein-after described. Area about 2,719 square feet.

B.—Five dwelling-houses on the north side of Devon Terrace, Bridge Road, Stratford, abutting south on Devon Terrace aforesaid, and north on the Girls British Board School, Bridge Road, Stratford. Area about 3,526 square feet.

C.—Three dwelling-houses, with piece of garden ground and pathway adjoining, situate on the west side of Woodward's Gardens, Bridge Road, Stratford, abutting south on Devon Terrace aforesaid, and north partly on the premises immediately herein-after described, and partly on the yards of other properties in Mount Street, Stratford. Area about 5,302 square feet.

D.—Four dwelling-houses on the south side of Mount Street, Stratford, abutting north on Mount Street aforesaid, and south on the premises immediately above described. Area about 2,395 square feet.

E.—Two dwelling-houses on the south side of Mount Street, Stratford, aforesaid, abutting north on Mount Street aforesaid, and south on the premises in Woodward's Gardens, above described. Area about 1,057 square feet.

North Hallsville, Canning Town, Site.

A.—A warehouse and stables on the west side of Burnham Street, Canning Town, abutting east on Burnham Street aforesaid, and west on yard in rear of premises in Victoria Dock Road. Area about 1,290 square feet.

B.—A dwelling-house (adjoining premises immediately herein-before described), on the west side of Burnham Street aforesaid, abutting east on Burnham Street aforesaid, and west on yards in rear of premises in Victoria Dock Road aforesaid. Area about 1,050 square feet.

C.—A shop and dwelling-house (adjoining premises immediately herein-before described), on the west side of Burnham Street aforesaid, abutting east on Burnham Street, and west on yards in rear of premises in Victoria Dock Road aforesaid. Area about 1,040 square feet.

Maryland Point, Stratford, Site.

A piece of vacant land on the south side of Arrow Street, Maryland Point abutting north on Arrow Street aforesaid, and south on other vacant land. Area about 12,000 square feet.

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
