



CHAPTER vii.

An Act to enable the County Council of the County of Dunbarton to borrow money for the purpose of erecting and enlarging County Buildings and for other purposes. A.D. 1897.
[8th April 1897.]

WHEREAS the county buildings belonging to the County Council of the county of Dunbarton (herein-after called "the County Council") are inadequate for the purposes of the County Council and the various bodies and persons for whom the County Council are bound or authorised to provide accommodation and it is expedient that additional county buildings should be erected and that the said county buildings should be altered and enlarged or reconstructed :

And whereas by the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1889 (herein-after called "the Local Government Act") the County Council are authorised to manage alter and enlarge county buildings but are not authorised to borrow money for such purpose and it is expedient that the County Council should be authorised to borrow money for the purpose of erecting such additional county buildings and of such alteration and enlargement or reconstruction :

And whereas the purposes of this Act cannot be effected without the authority of Parliament :

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the Dunbarton County Buildings Act 1897. Short title.

2. The County Council with the consent of the standing joint committee of the county of Dunbarton may raise any sum of money not exceeding the sum of ten thousand pounds for the purpose of erecting additional county buildings at Dunbarton and

County Council may borrow for purposes of erecting

additional buildings and of acquiring land for any of such purposes by
and altering borrowing upon the security of the general purposes rate leviable
&c. existing by them under and by virtue of the Local Government Act as if
county the money so borrowed were money authorised to be borrowed
buildings. under the authority of that Act.

Costs of Act. **3.** All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the
preparing for obtaining and passing of this Act or otherwise in
relation thereto shall be paid by the County Council out of the
rates and assessments leviable by them under the authority of the
Local Government Act or out of the moneys to be borrowed under
the authority of this Act.
