



## CHAPTER lxxix.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the Board of Trade under the General Pier and Harbour Act 1861 relating to Killala. A.D. 1897.  
—  
[15th July 1897.]

**W**HEREAS a Provisional Order made by the Board of Trade under the General Pier and Harbour Act 1861 is not of any validity or force whatever until the confirmation thereof by Act of Parliament: 24 & 25 Vict.  
c. 45.

And whereas it is expedient that the Provisional Order made by the Board of Trade under the said Act and set out in the schedule to this Act be confirmed by Act of Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule to this Act shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof in manner and form as they are set out in the said schedule shall from and after the passing of this Act have full validity and force. Confirmation

2. The undertakers mentioned in the said Order shall not under the powers of this Act or of the said Order purchase or acquire in any urban sanitary district as defined by the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 ten or more houses which after the passing of this Act have been or on the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either wholly or partially by persons belonging to the labouring class as tenants or lodgers. For the purposes of this section the expression "labouring class" includes mechanics artizans labourers and others working for wages hawkers costermongers persons not working for wages but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others except

A.D. 1897. — members of their own family and persons other than domestic servants whose income does not exceed an average of thirty shillings a week and the families of any of such persons who may be residing with them.

Short title.      **3.** This Act may be cited as the Pier and Harbour Order Confirmation (No. 2) Act 1897.

## KILLALA.

*Order for Reviving the powers of and Extending the time for the construction of the Works authorised by the Killala Pier Order 1892.*

1. The Killala Pier Order 1892 (in this Order called the Order of 1892) shall be read and have effect as varied by this Order. Order of 1892 varied.

2. The powers conferred by the Order of 1892 upon the Undertakers thereunder and all the provisions of that Order shall be and the same are hereby revived and may be exercised and enforced and shall have effect in like manner and subject to the like restrictions and with the same consequences whether as to commencement or cesser of powers execution or completion of works or levying of rates or otherwise as if such powers and provisions had been contained in this Order and the Order of 1892 and this Order shall be read and have effect accordingly. Powers of Order of 1892 revived.

3. All costs charges and expenses of or incident to preparing and obtaining this Order or otherwise incurred in relation thereto shall be paid by the Undertakers. Costs of Order.

4. This Order may be cited as the Killala Pier Order 1897 and the Order of 1892 and this Order may be cited together as the Killala Pier Orders 1892 and 1897. Short title.
