# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

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*Cap. clxv.*

An Act to amend the Acts relating to the *London and South-western* Railway; and to authorize Extensions thereof from the *Nine Elms* Terminus to a Point near to *Waterloo* and *Hungerford* Bridges in the Parish of *Saint Mary Lambeth*, and to the *Thames* at *Nine Elms* in the Parish of *Battersea*, all in the County of *Surrey*.

[31st July 1845.]

**W**HEREAS an Act was passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King *William* the Fourth, intituled *An Act for making a Railway from London to Southampton*, and by the said Act several Persons were incorporated by the Name and Style of “The *London and Southampton* Railway Company,” for carrying into execution the said Undertaking; and the Company were thereby empowered to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves, the Sum of One million Pounds, in Twenty thousand Shares of Fifty Pounds each, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking,

the Sum of Three hundred and thirty thousand Pounds: And whereas another Act was passed in the First Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to alter the Line of the London and Southampton Railway, and to amend the Act relating thereto*, whereby further Powers were granted to the Company with reference to the said Undertaking; and the Company were empowered to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves or otherwise, the further Sum of Four hundred thousand Pounds, in One thousand six hundred Shares of Twenty-five Pounds each, every such Share being equivalent to a Fifty Pound Share in respect of Profits and Privileges, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking, the Sum of Four hundred and sixty thousand Pounds, instead of the Sum of Three hundred and thirty thousand Pounds by the said recited Act of the Fifth Year of His said late Majesty authorized to be borrowed: And whereas another Act was passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend the Acts relating to the London and Southampton Railway Company (thereafter to be called "The London and South-western Railway Company")*, and to make a *Branch Railway to the Port of Portsmouth*, whereby the Company were required to take and use the Name and Style of "*The London and South-western Railway Company,*" and were empowered to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves or otherwise, the further Sum of Three hundred thousand Pounds, in Six thousand Shares of Fifty Pounds each, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking, the Sum of Five hundred and sixty thousand Pounds, instead of the Sum of Four hundred and sixty thousand Pounds by the said recited Act of the First Year of Her present Majesty authorized to be borrowed; and by the said Act now in recital Powers were granted to the Company as well for constructing the said Branch Railway as for effecting the general Purposes of the Company: And whereas another Act was passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend the Acts relating to the London and South-western Railway Company*, whereby the Company were authorized to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves or otherwise, the further Sum of Two hundred and ten thousand Pounds, in Four thousand two hundred Shares of Fifty Pounds each, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking, the Sum of Six hundred and thirty thousand Pounds, instead of the Sum of Five hundred and sixty thousand Pounds by the said recited Act of the Second Year of Her present Majesty authorized to be borrowed; and by the said Act now in recital further Powers were granted to the Company for effecting the general Purposes of the said Undertaking: And whereas another Act was passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend the Acts relating to the London and South-western Railway Company, and to authorize an Agreement between the said Company and certain Inhabitants of Wandsworth and Battersea respecting an alleged Loss in their Supply of Water*, whereby further Powers were granted to the Company for effecting the Purpose last aforesaid: And whereas another Act was passed in the



the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to make a Branch Railway from the London and South-western Railway to Salisbury*, whereby the Company were authorized to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves or otherwise, the further Sum of Two hundred and forty thousand Pounds, in Six thousand Shares of Forty Pounds each, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking, the further Sum of Eighty thousand Pounds, in addition to the said Sum of Six hundred and thirty thousand Pounds by the said recited Act of the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty authorized to be borrowed; and by the said Act now in recital further Powers were granted to the Company as well for constructing the said Branch Railway as for effecting the general Purposes of the said Undertaking: And whereas another Act was passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend the Acts relating to the London and South-western Railway, and to authorize the Extension of the said Railway and other Works at or near the Nine Elms Station*, whereby the Company were authorized to raise, by Subscription amongst themselves or otherwise, the further Sum of Twelve thousand five hundred Pounds, in Two hundred and fifty Shares of Fifty Pounds each, and to borrow and take up at Interest, upon the Credit of the said Undertaking, the further Sum of Four thousand one hundred and fifty Pounds; and further Powers were granted to the Company as well for executing the said last-mentioned Extension and Works as for effecting the general Purposes of the said Undertaking: And whereas the said Railway and Branch Railway by the said recited Acts of the Fifth Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty and the First and Second Years of Her said present Majesty authorized to be made have been completed and opened, and the Branch Railway to *Salisbury* by the said recited Act of the Eighth Year of Her said present Majesty authorized to be made is in course of Construction: And whereas the Extension of the said Railway from the present *Nine Elms* Station to the *York Road*, and the Improvement of the present Means of Communication between the said Railway and the River *Thames* at *Nine Elms* aforesaid, and of landing and embarking Passengers and Goods from and by the said River, would be a great public Benefit: And whereas the Company are willing to make and complete the said Extension of their said Railway, with all proper Works and Conveniences in connexion therewith, herein-after called the "*Lambeth Extension*," and also to improve the present Means of Communication between the said Railway and the *Thames* at *Nine Elms* aforesaid, and the existing Accommodation for landing and embarking Passengers and Goods there, by laying down an additional Line of Railway from the said *Nine Elms* Station to the said River, and by extending and improving the Works and Conveniences already provided by the Company in connexion with the said River (which said last-mentioned Extension and Improvements are herein-after called "*The Nine Elms Extension*"); but the Company are unable to do so without the Authority of Parliament, and it is expedient that Powers should be granted to them for such Purposes, and for better effecting the Purposes

Purposes of the said recited Acts: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That all Provisions, Matters, and Things contained in the said recited Acts or any of them, (so far as the same are now unrepealed, and except such of them, or such Parts thereof, as are by this Act repealed, altered, or otherwise provided for, and except such of the said Provisions, Matters, and Things as are, with respect to the Purposes and Things hereby authorized to be done, otherwise provided for by the Incorporation herein of "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845," and "The Railway Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845,") shall extend to the several Purposes and Things hereby authorized to be done, as fully and effectually as if the same several Provisions, Matters, and Things were repeated and re-enacted in this Act with reference to such Purposes and Things.

II. And be it enacted, That the several Acts of Parliament following, that is to say, "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845," and "The Railway Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845," shall be incorporated with and form Part of this Act.

Short Title.

III. And be it enacted, That in citing this Act in other Acts of Parliament and in legal Instruments it shall be sufficient to use the Expression "*The London and South-western Railway Metropolitan Extensions Act, 1845.*"

Capital.

IV. And whereas the estimated Expence of making the Railways and Works is Eight hundred thousand Pounds; be it therefore enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Company to raise, by Contribution amongst themselves, or by the Admission of other Parties as Subscribers to the Undertaking, or in part by each of those Means, the further Sum of Eight hundred thousand Pounds, to be divided into such Number of Shares, and the said Shares to be of such respective Amounts, as the Directors of the said Company shall determine; and the said several Shares shall be duly numbered in regular Order of arithmetical Progression, and every Share shall always be distinguished by the Number to be originally applied to the same.

V. And be it enacted, That the said new Shares hereby authorized to be created shall be respectively vested in the several Corporations and Persons who have subscribed and shall hereafter subscribe for the same respectively, and their respective Successors, Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, to their proper Use and Benefit, proportionally to the Sums by them respectively subscribed; and all Corporations and Persons who have subscribed or shall subscribe for One or more of the said new Shares by this Act authorized to be created, or such Sum or Sums as shall be demanded in lieu thereof, and their respective Successors, Executors, Administrators,  
and



and Assigns, shall be and they are hereby declared to be Owners and Proprietors of Stock in the said Company to the same Extent, and as beneficially to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever (except as herein-after is mentioned), as Proprietors of the like nominal Amount of the Capital of the said Company by the said recited Act of the Fifth Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty King *William* the Fourth authorized to be created in Shares, and shall, in respect of the said new Shares by this Act authorized to be created (except as aforesaid), be entitled to all such Rights and Privileges, and be under and subject to all the Powers, Provisions, Indemnities, Remedies, Penalties, Clauses, Matters, and Things contained in the said recited Acts or any of them, so far as the same are now unrepealed, and are not by this Act repealed, altered, or otherwise provided for.

VI. Provided always, and be it enacted, That no Proprietor of any new Share by this Act authorized to be created shall be entitled to any further or greater Dividend thereon than in respect of or to the Extent of the Amount which may for the Time being have been paid up on such new Share, nor to any Dividend calculated from any Day prior to the First Day of *January* or the First Day of *July* which shall occur immediately subsequent to the complete opening for public Traffic or Use of the Railways and Works by this Act authorized, and of the several other Railways and Works (if any) which the said *London and South-western* Railway Company, by any Act or Acts of Parliament to be passed in this present Session of Parliament, shall be authorized to make, or towards which they shall by any such Act or Acts be authorized to subscribe, whichever of the said complete Openings (if the said Company in this present Session be authorized to make or subscribe towards more than One such Railway) shall last happen.

VII. Provided also, and be it enacted, That Interest (after the Rate of Four Pounds *per Centum per Annum*) shall be paid by the said Company half-yearly, out of the Capital hereby authorized to be created, to the Proprietors of the said new Shares, that is to say, from the First Day of *July* One thousand eight hundred and forty-five, upon the Amount which shall on or previously to that Day have been paid upon the said new Shares, and from the respective Times of their subsequent Payment upon the future Calls or Instalments which shall from Time to Time be paid thereupon; and such Interest shall continue to be payable up to the Day on which, under the Provisions herein contained, the first Dividend shall begin to grow due on the said new Shares.

VIII. Provided also, and be it enacted, That from the Time or respective Times at which the Railways and Works by this Act authorized to be made, or either of them, or any One or more of the Lines of Railway towards which the said Company may by any Act or Acts passed in the present Session of Parliament be authorized to subscribe, shall be wholly open for public Traffic or Use, and until

the Day on which, under the Provisions herein contained, the first Dividend shall begin to grow due on the said new Shares, a Sum equal to Four Pounds *per Centum per Annum* on the Amount actually expended or subscribed and paid up by the said Company in or towards the Construction of the Line or Lines of Railway or the Works so first completely opened for public Traffic or Use as aforesaid shall be applied out of the general Revenues of the said *London and South-western Railway Company* in or towards Payment of the Interest herein-before provided to be paid out of the Capital hereby authorized to be created, instead of the said last-mentioned Sum or Amount of Interest continuing to be paid out of such Capital.

As to voting in respect of new Shares if not created as Fifty Pound Shares.

IX. Provided also, and be it enacted, That no Proprietor of the said new Shares which (if any) under the Authority herein-before contained shall be issued by the Directors of any other nominal Amount than the nominal Amount of Fifty Pounds *per Share* shall be entitled to vote in respect of the Number of such Shares held by him ; but, for the Purpose of voting, the Amount of Capital in the said Company represented by all such new Shares so held by him shall be considered as divided into as many Fifty Pound Shares as such Amount of Capital will admit of, and the Right of voting of such Proprietor in respect of such new Shares shall be determined by the Number of Fifty Pound Shares into which the Amount of Capital represented by the said new Shares held by him shall be capable of being divided.

Power to make Calls on new Shares.

X. And be it enacted, That the Directors of the said Company shall have Power, from Time to Time and at any Time or Times after the passing of this Act, to make, at their Discretion, such Call or Calls of Money from the Subscribers to and Proprietors of the said new Shares by this Act authorized to be created as the said Directors shall from Time to Time find necessary for the Purposes of the said Company, so that no such Call shall exceed the Sum of Five Pounds upon each new Share, and so that there shall be an Interval of Three Calendar Months at least between the Day of Payment of every Two successive Calls.

Notice to be given when Call made.

XI. And be it enacted, That the several Sums of Money so to be called for shall be paid into such Banks or to such Persons, and (subject to the Restrictions herein-before contained) at such Time and Place, and in such Manner, as the said Directors shall from Time to Time direct and appoint, of which Time and Place Twenty-one Days Notice at least shall be previously given by Advertisement, under the Hand of the Secretary of the said Company, inserted in Two or more of the daily *London Newspapers*, and in One or more Newspaper or Newspapers usually circulated in each of the Counties of *Surrey, Southampton, and Wilts*; and all the Powers, Provisions, Remedies, Penalties, Forfeitures, Matters, and Things created or imposed by the said recited Act of the First Year of Her said present Majesty, and the said recited Act of the Fifth Year of His said late Majesty



Majesty (as altered and amended by the said first-mentioned Act), for compelling the Payment of Calls, and for forfeiting the Shares of such Proprietors as shall be in default, and for Payment of Subscriptions in advance, in case the Directors shall think proper to accept the same, shall extend and be applicable to the said new Shares by this Act authorized to be created, as fully and effectually, to all Intents and Purposes, as if the same had been repeated and re-enacted in this Act in respect of the said new Shares hereby authorized to be created: Provided always, that no Proprietor or Owner of any new Share hereby authorized to be created shall in any Case be liable to pay any greater Sum in the whole in respect of any such new Share than the Sum or Amount at which such new Share may be issued by the Directors under the Authority aforesaid.

XII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Company, when and so soon as One Half of the total Amount of the Capital of the said Company so as aforesaid authorized to be raised by Subscription shall have been actually raised and paid up, by an Order of any General or Special General Meeting of the said Company, from Time to Time to borrow and take up at Interest any further or additional Sum of Money, not exceeding (besides and exclusive of the Sums of Money already authorized to be raised as aforesaid, and besides and exclusive of any Sum or Sums which the said Company may be authorized to raise by the passing of any other Act or Acts in this present Session of Parliament,) the Sum of Two hundred and thirty-three thousand Pounds, on the Credit of the said *London and South-western* Railway, including the Branches and Extensions thereof, as to them shall seem proper, and thereupon to secure the Repayment thereof, with Interest, to such Persons as shall be found willing to lend the same, by such Mortgages, Assignments, or Bonds as are authorized by the said recited Acts in respect of the Sum thereby authorized to be borrowed.

Power to borrow extended to 233,000*l.* beyond the Amount already authorized to be borrowed.

XIII. And be it enacted, That all the Powers, Authorities, Provisions, Directions, Remedies, Regulations, Matters, and Things in the said recited Acts contained, relating to or in anywise affecting the borrowing of Money, and the Augmentation of Capital Stock instead of borrowing, or by the Conversion of Money borrowed into Capital Stock, and relating to or in anywise affecting Mortgages and Assignments, and Transfers of Mortgages and Assignments, and Mortgagees and Assignees, and Transferees of Mortgagees and Assignees, shall extend and be applicable to the said additional Sum of Two hundred and thirty-three thousand Pounds hereby authorized to be raised as aforesaid, in the same Manner as the same extend and are applicable by the said recited Acts to the Sum thereby authorized to be borrowed as aforesaid.

XIV. Provided always, and be it enacted, That every Mortgage, Bond, or other Security for Money, and every Transfer of any Share, Mortgage, Bond, or other Security for Money, to be granted

or made by virtue of this Act, shall be by Deed duly stamped, wherein the Consideration for the same shall be truly stated; any thing herein or in the said Acts contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

XV. And whereas Plans and Sections of the said *Lambeth* and *Nine Elms* Extensions of the said Railway, showing the respective Lines and Levels thereof, and also Books of Reference containing the Names of the Owners, Lessees, and Occupiers, or reputed Owners and Lessees and Occupiers of the Lands through which the same are respectively intended to pass, have been deposited with the Clerk of the Peace of the County of *Surrey*; be it enacted, That, subject to the Provisions in this and the said recited Acts contained, it shall be lawful for the said Company to make and maintain the said Railways and Works in the several Lines and upon the Lands delineated on the said several Plans and described in the said Books of Reference, and to enter upon, take, and use such of the said Lands as shall be necessary for such Purpose.

XVI. And be it enacted, That the said *Lambeth* Extension of the said Railway shall commence at and proceed from the *London and South-western* Railway near to and on the South Side of the *Nine Elms* Terminus thereof in the Parish of *Battersea* in the County of *Surrey*, and shall pass through the several Places of *Battersea*, *Nine Elms*, *Vauxhall*, *South Lambeth*, *Kennington*, and *Saint Mary Lambeth*, or some or One of them, in the same County, and shall terminate at or near the Plot of Ground, and Buildings thereon, bounded on the North by the *York Road*, on the East by *Cross Street*, on the South by *Harlington Street*, and on the West by *Griffin Street*, all in the Parish of *Saint Mary Lambeth* in the said County.

XVII. And be it enacted, That the said *Nine Elms* Extension of the said Railway shall commence at or near the first Foot Bridge under the said *London and South-western* Railway at *Nine Elms* aforesaid, and end at or near *Belmont Wharf*, abutting on the River *Thames* at *Nine Elms* aforesaid, now or late in the Occupation of Mrs. *Elizabeth Norton*, and all which last-mentioned Railway, Works, and Conveniences will be made in the said Parish of *Battersea*.

XVIII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Line of the said *Nine Elms Extension* Railway to cross on the Level the public Highway numbered 13 on the deposited Plan of the same Railway: Provided always, that no locomotive Steam Engine in use upon the same Railway shall at any Time cross the said public Highway.

XIX. And whereas the said Extension of the said Railway is intended to cross the great public Carriage Road called *Westminster Bridge Road* or *Mount Street*; now be it enacted, That the said Extension of the said Railway shall not be carried across the said Road



Road otherwise than by means of One Arch, of sufficient Span to embrace at once the said Carriage Road and the Two Side Paths or Footways, and to be supported by Piers which shall not extend into the said Road or Side Paths or Footways beyond the Line of the Fronts of the present Houses on either Side of the said Paths or Footways, so that there may be preserved to the Public the same free and uninterrupted Passage it now enjoys.

XX. And be it enacted, That the Company shall not take or injure any Property of the following Kinds, except such as shall be specified in the Schedule to this Act, without the Consent in Writing of the Owners and Occupiers thereof; (that is to say,) any House or Building erected on or before the Thirtieth Day of *November* One thousand eight hundred and forty-four, or any Ground on or before that Day inclosed or set apart and used as a Garden, Orchard, Nursery Ground, Yard, Paddock, Plantation, planted Walk, or Avenue to a House. Houses and enclosed Grounds not to be taken unless specified in the Schedule.

XXI. And be it enacted, That the Quantity of Land to be taken by the Company for extraordinary Purposes in connexion with the Railways and Works hereby authorized to be made shall not exceed Twenty-five Acres. Lands for additional Stations, &c.

XXII. And be it enacted, That the Powers of the Company for the compulsory Purchase of Lands for the Purposes of this Act shall not be exercised after the Expiration of Three Years from the passing of this Act. Period within which Lands are to be purchased.

XXIII. And be it enacted, That the Railway and Works shall be completed within Seven Years from the passing of this Act, and on the Expiration of such Period the Powers by this or the recited Acts granted to the Company for executing the Railway, or otherwise in relation thereto, shall cease to be exercised, except as to so much of the Railway as shall then be completed. Period for Completion of Works.

XXIV. And be it enacted, That the Company may, subject to the Provisions in the said recited Acts and this Act contained, lawfully demand and receive, in respect of the said Railways and Works hereby authorized to be made, for the Tonnage of all Articles, Matters, and Things conveyed upon the same or any Part thereof respectively, and in respect of Passengers, Beasts, Cattle, and Animals conveyed in Carriages, and for Carriages conveyed on the same or any Part thereof respectively, and for and in respect of locomotive Engines, or other Power for drawing or propelling, supplied by the Company, and for the Conveyance upon the same Railways or any Part thereof respectively, in Waggons or Carriages belonging to the Company, of any Passengers, Cattle or other Animals, Goods, Wares, Merchandize, Articles, Matters, and Things, and for Wharfage, Warehousing, and Cranage, such Amount of Rates, Tolls, and other Charges as by the said recited Acts the Company are authorized to demand and receive in respect of Company to take same Tolls as on Main Lines.

XXV. Provided always, and be it enacted, That the maximum Charges to be made by the Company in respect of all the Tolls and Charges for the Use of the Railways, and Carriages, Waggon, or Trucks, and for locomotive Power, and every Expence incidental to such Conveyance, except the loading and unloading of Goods where such Service is performed by the Company, shall not exceed the Sums following; that is to say,

In respect of the Tonnage of Articles conveyed upon the said *London and South-western and Extension* Railways, as follows:

For all Coals, and Articles in the said Act of the Fifth Year of His said late Majesty classed therewith, Three-pence *per Ton per Mile*:

For all Cotton, and Articles in the said Act classed therewith, Four-pence Farthing *per Ton per Mile*:

For all Silk, and Articles in the said Act classed therewith, Five-pence Halfpenny *per Ton per Mile*:

In respect of Passengers and Animals conveyed in Carriages upon the said *London and South-western and Extension* Railways, or any Part thereof respectively, as follows:

For every Person conveyed in a First Class Carriage, the Sum of Three-pence *per Mile*:

For every Passenger conveyed in a Second Class Carriage, the Sum of Two-pence *per Mile*:

For every Passenger conveyed in a Third Class Carriage, the Sum of Three Halfpence *per Mile*:

For every Horse, Mule, Ass, or other Beast of Draught or Burden, and for every Ox, Cow, Bull, or Neat Cattle, Five-pence *per Mile*:

For every Calf or Pig, Sheep, Lamb, or other small Animal, Two-pence Halfpenny:

Provided also, that the said maximum Tolls and Charges shall not extend to Goods or Passengers conveyed by or in any special or express Train.

tion of the said Railway, or any Part thereof, and also such Satisfaction, Recompence, and Compensation for any Damage, Loss, Injury, or Inconvenience, whether temporary, perpetual, or recurring, and whether arising by or by means of Severance or otherwise, which any of the Lands or Possessions of the said Duchy shall or may sustain by reason or in consequence of the Formation or Construction of the said Railway or any Part thereof, or any Works, Matters, or Things appertaining thereunto, or in any way connected therewith, as shall be settled and agreed upon between the Council of His said Royal Highness, or other the Commissioners for managing the Affairs of the said Duchy of *Cornwall*, for the Time being, and the said Railway Company, together with all the Costs, Charges, and Expences incurred on the Behalf of the said Duchy of *Cornwall* in ascertaining and settling the Price, Recompence, or Compensation so to be paid or made to His said Royal Highness, His Heirs and Successors, by the said Railway Company, for or in respect of any Property of the said Duchy of *Cornwall* so required and authorized to be taken as aforesaid, and also the Expences to be incurred on behalf of the said Duchy of *Cornwall* in ascertaining and settling the Accommodation Works to be made, erected, executed, and maintained by the said Railway Company under the Provision in that Behalf herein-after contained, including all Expences preparatory or incident to the Premises, or in any way connected therewith, as well before as after the passing of this Act; and nothing in this Act contained shall extend to authorize or empower the said Railway Company to enter upon, take, hold, or use any Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments, Parcel of the Possessions of the said Duchy of *Cornwall*, until the Price, Recompence, or Compensation to be paid or made by the said Railway Company for the same shall have been settled and agreed upon as aforesaid, and until the Amount of the same, together with such Costs, Charges, and Expences as aforesaid, shall have been paid by the said Railway Company, and the necessary Conveyances shall have been duly completed and perfected, any thing in this Act, or in the Acts incorporated herewith, or either of them, contained, notwithstanding; and further, that the said Railway Company shall make, erect, execute, and maintain all such Works for the Accommodation of adjoining Lands as shall be settled and agreed upon between the Council of His said Royal Highness, or other the Commissioners for managing the Affairs of the said Duchy of *Cornwall*, for the Time being, and the said Railway Company: Provided always, that in case any Difference shall arise with regard to the Price, Satisfaction, Recompence, or Compensation to be paid or made by the said Railway Company to His Royal Highness, His Heirs and Successors, or as to the Works required for the Accommodation of adjoining Lands, or otherwise in respect of or in relation to the Premises, then and in that Case the said Council or Commissioners for the Time being shall, within One Month after they shall be required so to do by Writing under the Hands of any Two or more of the Directors for the Time being of the said Railway Company, name Three Surveyors; and the said Railway Company shall thereupon, within Ten Days from the Receipt of the Names of such Surveyors, give Notice in Writing to the said Council or Commis-



sioners for the Time being, under the Hands of any Two or more of the Directors for the Time being of the said Railway Company, which of such Surveyors the said Railway Company elect to be the Arbitrator to whom the Matters in difference between the said Railway Company and the said Council or Commissioners for the Time being shall be referred, whose Award or Determination thereon, if made in Writing and under his Hand and Seal within Three Calendar Months from the Date of such Reference, shall be binding and conclusive on His said Royal Highness, His Heirs and Successors, and also on the said Railway Company.

XLII. Provided always, and be it enacted, That nothing in this Act, or in the Acts incorporated herewith, or either of them, contained, shall extend to abridge, lessen, or abrogate any of the Powers or Authorities by Law vested in the Council of His Royal Highness the Duke of *Cornwall* in relation to the Lands or Possessions of the Duchy of *Cornwall*.

XLIII. Provided always, and be it enacted, That nothing in this Act, or in the Acts incorporated herewith, or either of them, contained, shall extend or be construed to extend to alienate, defeat, vary, lessen, abrogate, or prejudice any Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Franchise, Royalty, Jurisdiction, or Authority of His Royal Highness the Duke of *Cornwall*, His Heirs or Successors, in right of His Duchy of *Cornwall*, save as the same are expressly altered or affected by the Provisions herein-before contained with respect to the Lands and Possessions of the said Duchy of *Cornwall*.

Saving the Rights of the Duchy of Cornwall.

XLIV. And whereas an Act was passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to provide for the Conveyance of the Mails by Railway*; and another Act was passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her said Majesty, intituled *An Act for regulating Railways*; and another Act was passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of Her said Majesty, intituled *An Act for the better Regulation of Railways, and for the Conveyance of Troops*; and another Act was passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of Her said Majesty, intituled *An Act to attach certain Conditions to the Construction of future Railways authorized or to be authorized by any Act of the present or succeeding Sessions of Parliament; and for other Purposes in relation to Railways*; be it enacted, That nothing in this said Act contained shall be held to exempt the said Railways or the said Company from the Provisions of the said several Acts respectively, but that such Provisions shall be in force in respect to the said Railways and Company so far as the same shall be applicable thereto.
