An Act to amend the several Acts for making and maintaining the *Ulster Canal* in the Counties of *Fermanagh* and *Armagh*. [23d August 1831.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King *George* the Fourth, intituled *An Act for making and maintaining a navigable Canal from Lough Erne, in the County of Fermanagh, to the River Blackwater near the Village of Charlemont in the County of Armagh*: And whereas an Act was passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend an Act for making and maintaining a navigable Canal from Lough Erne, in the County of Fermanagh, to the River Blackwater near the Village of Charlemont in the County of Armagh*: And whereas an Act was passed in the Tenth Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, intituled *An Act to explain the Acts for making the Ulster Canal in the Counties of Fermanagh and Armagh*: And whereas the Time limited by the second of the said recited Acts for making and completing the said Canal will expire on the Twentieth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and thirty-three: And whereas the Company of Proprietors incorporated by the said Act have been unable to raise the Funds necessary for the Execution of the said Canal in Time to have it completed within the Period aforesaid, and it is therefore necessary that the Time limited for such Completion should be extended: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent

cellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the Period limited by the said secondly-recited Act for the Completion of the said Canal and other Works authorized to be made under the said recited Acts shall be and the same is hereby extended to the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven, and that all Powers, Authorities, Provisions, Penalties, Forfeitures, Matters, and Things in relation to the making and completing the said Canal and other Works contained in the said recited Acts, or any or either of them, and now in force, shall be and remain and continue in full Force and Effect for the Purposes of the said recited Acts and of this Act, during such further Period as aforesaid, as fully and effectually in all respects and to all Intents and Purposes as if such extended Period had been given by the said recited Acts or either of them, and as if all and singular the Powers, Authorities, Provisions, Penalties, Forfeitures, Matters, and Things contained in the said recited Acts had been specially and particularly re-enacted in and made Part of this Act.

II. And be it further enacted, That the Costs, Charges, and Expences of applying for and obtaining this Act shall be paid and defrayed out of the first Monies to be raised by virtue of the said recited Acts or this Act, or any or either of them.

Public Act.

III. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.
