An Act to authorize the raising of further Monies
for supplying the Town of *Manchester* with Gas.
[15th *March* 1831.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Fifth Year of the
Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, inti-
tuled *An Act for better lighting with Gas the Town of* 5 G. 4. c. 133.
Manchester in the County Palatine of Lancaster: And whereas
another Act was passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His said
late Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend several Acts for cleansing,* 9 G. 4. c. 117.
lighting, watching, improving, and regulating the Towns of Manchester
and Salford in the County Palatine of Lancaster: And whereas another
Act was passed in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of His said late
Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend several Acts for supplying the* 11 G. 4. c. 47.
Town of Manchester with Gas, and for regulating and improving the
same Town: And whereas the Directors acting in execution of the
said first and third recited Acts, and pursuant to the Authorities
therein respectively contained, have raised the several Sums of
Thirty-five thousand Pounds and Twenty-five thousand Pounds,
making the aggregate Sum of Sixty thousand Pounds, and have
expended such aggregate Sum, in the Manner expressed and contained
in the said first and third recited Acts, for or towards the establish-
ing, improving, and extending certain Gas Works, and the several
Articles, Matters, and Things therewith connected, within and belong-
ing to the said Town of *Manchester*, and which, by virtue of the said
several recited Acts, or One of them, are placed under the Controul
[*Local.*] Q q and

and Management of the said Directors: And whereas, by the continued Increase of Demand for Gas within the Limits of the said recited Acts, a larger Supply thereof hath become necessary than can be furnished by the said Works, and further Monies are required, the better to enable the said Directors to meet such continued Increase of Demand for Gas as aforesaid, and the more fully to accomplish the Purposes of the said first and third recited Acts, relative to the said Works: And whereas, for better enabling the said Directors to repay the said aggregate Sum already raised and expended, and to raise such further Monies as aforesaid, it is expedient that they should have extended Authority for taking up Monies as herein mentioned; but that Object cannot be effected without the Aid of Parliament: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the said Three several recited Acts, and all and every the Powers, Provisions, Pains, Penalties, Forfeitures, Exemptions, Matters, and Things therein respectively contained, so far as they respectively relate to or are in anywise connected with the said Gas Works, as the same Acts are successively altered and varied by each other, and except as to such Parts thereof as are repealed, shall be extended to this Act, and shall be as good, valid, and effectual for carrying this Act into execution as if the same had been respectively repeated and re-enacted in the Body of this Act.

Power to
borrow addi-

II. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Directors acting in execution of the said first and third recited Acts from Time to Time to borrow and take up, at Interest, in addition to the Money which they were authorized and empowered to raise by and under the said first and third recited Acts respectively, any Sum and Sums of Money, and in such Proportions as they shall think fit, giving a Security or Securities for the same by a Mortgage or Mortgages in the Manner expressed and contained in the said first-recited Act with respect to Money thereby authorized to be borrowed; and the said additional Sum and Sums of Money, and every Part thereof, when raised, shall, subject to the Payment of the Expences of applying for, preparing, obtaining, and passing this Act, as herein-after mentioned, be laid out and applied in the Manner expressed and contained in the said first and third recited Acts relative to the Application of the Money borrowed under and by virtue of the same Acts respectively; and all Holders of Assignments and Securities granted or to be granted under the Authority of the said first and third recited Acts and this Act, or any of them, and their respective Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, shall respectively be entitled to, and have, hold, receive, take, and enjoy the said Works, and the Property and Effects thereof, and the Rents, Profits, and Monies arising therefrom, in the Proportions which the Sum and Sums of Money advanced and lent by such Holders respectively do and shall bear to the whole Sum at any Time or Times borrowed by virtue of the said first and third recited Acts and this Act, or any of them.

III. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That the said additional Sum and Sums to be from Time to Time borrowed under the Authority of this Act shall not exceed the Sum of Fifty thousand Pounds in the whole : Provided also, that the said additional Sum or Sums to be from Time to Time borrowed or taken up as aforesaid, together with the Principal Money which for the Time then being may be due and owing on any Mortgage or Mortgages previously granted under the Authority of the said first and third recited Acts or this Act, shall not at any Time exceed the Sum of Eighty thousand Pounds in the whole.

Money borrowed under this Act not to exceed 50,000*l.*, and the whole Mortgage Debt not at any Time to exceed 80,000*l.*

IV. And be it further enacted, That all the Costs, Charges, and Expences of and attending the applying for, preparing, obtaining, and passing this Act shall be paid and discharged by the said Directors by and out of the additional Sum and Sums of Money to be raised as aforesaid, before any Part thereof be applied to the other Purposes by this Act specified.

Expences of Act to be paid out of Money borrowed.

V. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.
