An Act for raising a further Sum of Money to defray the outstanding Claims in respect of the building the Crypt and Tower to the additional Church erected in the Parish of *Saint Mary Magdalen Bermondsey* in the County of *Surrey*, and of inclosing the Burial Ground thereof.

[30th *March* 1831.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Seventh Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act for raising Money for building a Crypt and Tower to the additional Church erecting in the Parish of Saint Mary Magdalen Bermondsey in the County of Surrey, for vesting the said Church and the Burial Ground thereof in Trustees, and for other Purposes relating thereto*: And whereas under and by virtue of the Powers in the said recited Act the Tower or Steeple therein mentioned has been erected, and proper and convenient Roads, Avenues, and Approaches made into and through the Burial Ground to the said Church, and the said Burial Ground fenced and inclosed, and the Engine House and Residence for an Engine Keeper erected, and an Organ, Bells, Ornaments, and other Conveniences necessary and proper for the Celebration of Divine Service according to the Rites of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland* as by Law established, have been erected and set up, and also certain Vaults, Catacombs,

and Arches made, formed, and constructed in the said Crypt, in pursuance and agreeable to the Provisions of the said recited Act: And whereas the Money in and by the said recited Act authorized to be raised has been borrowed under the Provisions thereof, but has been found insufficient for the Purposes therein mentioned; and certain Debts were incurred in respect thereof, some of which Debts to the Amount of Two thousand three hundred Pounds have been discharged by the said Trustees and their Treasurer with their own private Money: And whereas it is expedient to give the Trustees under the said recited Act Power to raise a further Sum of Money, and to make an additional Rate or Assessment, in order to repay the said Sum of Two thousand three hundred Pounds so advanced as aforesaid, and to discharge the remaining outstanding Debts: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the said recited Act, and all and every the Powers, Provisions, Exemptions, Penalties, Forfeitures, Payments, Remedies, Matters, and Things therein contained, (save and except such as are varied, altered, or repealed,) shall respectively be as good, valid, and effectual for carrying this Act into execution as if the same had respectively been repeated and re-enacted in the Body of this Act.

II. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the said Trustees from Time to Time to raise or borrow and take up at Interest, by way of Mortgage, Annuity, or otherwise, such further Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding in the whole the Sum of Three thousand Pounds, as they shall judge necessary, as well for the Purpose of repaying the said Sum of Two thousand three hundred Pounds so advanced by the said Trustees and their Treasurer as aforesaid, and Interest thereon, as of discharging the remaining outstanding Debts, and the Costs and Expences of this Act, upon the Credit of the Rates and Assessments to be made, levied, and collected by virtue of this Act.

Power to
make a Rate.

III. And be it further enacted, That for the Purpose of raising Money to carry this Act fully into execution it shall be lawful for the Trustees under the said recited Act from Time to Time, as they may think necessary, by Writing under their Hands, to make an Assessment or Assessments, Rate or Rates, in addition to any Rate or Assessment authorized to be made under the said recited Act, on the Occupiers of all Lands, Houses, Shops, Warehouses, Vaults, Coach-houses, Cellars, Stables, Gardens, Tenements, and Hereditaments within the Parish of *Saint Mary Magdalen Bermondsey*, of any Sum of Money not exceeding Two-pence in the Pound in any One Year, according to such Proportions of the yearly Value as the same Lands, Houses, Shops, Warehouses, Vaults, Coach-houses, Cellars, Stables, Gardens, Tenements, and Hereditaments shall from Time to Time be assessed to the Rate for the Relief of the Poor of the said Parish; and to order and direct the Collector or Collectors appointed or to be appointed in pursuance of the said recited Act to collect and receive from such Occupiers as aforesaid such Rates and

Sums of Money as shall be assessed or rated as aforesaid ; all which Rates and Assessments so to be rated, assessed, and collected are hereby vested in the said Trustees, in Trust to be by them applied for the Purposes in this Act contained, and shall take place from such Time, and be paid and payable at such Time or Times, and in such Proportions as the said Trustees shall direct and appoint.

IV. And be it further enacted, That all Houses and Buildings which shall hereafter be erected and built in the said Parish shall be rated and assessed, for the Purposes in this Act mentioned, in the same Manner and Proportion as other Houses or Buildings within the said Parish shall be then rated and assessed for the like Purposes.

Houses hereafter to be erected to be rated.

V. And be it further enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Trustees to include in One Rate or Assessment the Rates or Assessments by this and the said recited Act authorized to be made ; provided that such Rate or Assessment shall not in any One Year exceed the Sum of Eight-pence in the Pound according to such Proportions of the yearly Value as the Lands, Houses, Shops, Warehouses, Vaults, Coach-houses, Cellars, Stables, Gardens, Tenements, and Hereditaments within the said Parish shall from Time to Time be assessed to the Rates for the Relief of the Poor thereof ; and that for the Purposes of this and the said recited Act the Year shall be computed from the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* to the Twenty-fifth Day of *March*.

Power to include in One Rate the Rates authorized by this and the said recited Act.

VI. And be it further enacted, That out of the Monies to be raised under the Powers of this Act it shall be lawful for the said Trustees to repay the said Sum of Two thousand three hundred Pounds so advanced as aforesaid, together with Interest for the same at the Rate of Four Pounds *per Centum per Annum*, from the Third Day of *September* One thousand eight hundred and thirty, and also to defray the Costs, Charges, and Expences of obtaining and passing this Act.

Power to repay Monies borrowed and Interest thereon and the Expences of this Act.

VII. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.
