Cap. xxxvii.

An Act for maintaining and improving several Roads
in the County of *Cardigan*. [6th May 1833.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Tenth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled *An Act* 10 G. 3. c. 55. for repairing and widening several Roads in the County of Cardigan: And whereas another Act was passed in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, intituled *An Act for continuing the* 31 G. 3. c. 97. Term and altering and enlarging the Powers of an Act made in the Tenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, for repairing several Roads in the County of Cardigan, and for repairing other Roads in the said County: And whereas another Act was passed in the Fifty-second Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, intituled *An Act for enlarging the Term and Powers of* 52 G. 3. c. 40. Two several Acts of His present Majesty, for repairing and widening several Roads in the County of Cardigan, and also for making other Roads in the said County: And whereas the Trustees appointed under or by virtue of the said recited Acts have, in pursuance of the Power thereby given to them, borrowed considerable Sums of Money on the Credit of the Tolls thereby granted, and a great Part thereof is still due and owing and unpaid, and the respective Terms granted by the said Acts are near expiring, and the said Roads cannot be maintained in sufficient Repair, nor can the Monies borrowed and now due and owing on the Credit of the Tolls thereby respectively granted be paid off, unless the Term and Powers of the said recited Acts be enlarged: And whereas it

is expedient that the said recited Acts should be repealed, and other Provisions should be granted in lieu thereof; but the Purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without the Aid and Authority of Parliament: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That upon the Third *Thursday* next after the passing of this Act the said Three several recited Acts, passed in the Tenth, Thirty-first, and Fifty-second Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King *George* the Third, shall be and the same are hereby declared to be repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be put in execution for and during the Term herein-after mentioned for the Purpose of maintaining and improving the Roads leading from the Town of *Newcastle* at the Borders of the County of *Carmarthen* to the Town of *Cardigan*; and from the said Town of *Newcastle* to a Place called *Troedyroyr*; and also from a Place called *Llandyssyl Bridge*, at the Borders of the County of *Carmarthen*, to the said Town of *Cardigan*; and also from a Place called *Llechryd Bridge*, at the Borders of the County of *Pembroke*, to the said Town of *Cardigan*; and from the said Town of *Cardigan* to the Town of *Lampeter*; and also from the Town of *Cardigan* to a certain Place called *Aberayron*, on the Road leading to the Town of *Aberystwyth*; also the Road leading from the Sea Port or Creek of *Aberporth*, through the Parishes of *Aberporth*, *Blaenporth*, *Tremain*, *Pembryn*, *Bettws-Ifan*, *Troedyroyr*, *Llandefriog*, *Llanfaiirtreligen*, and *Henllan*, to *Henllan Bridge* on the River *Teifi*; the Road leading from *Henllan Bridge* aforesaid, through the Parishes of *Henllan* and *Llanfairoerllwyn*, to join the Turnpike Road leading from *Atpar* to *Lampeter* at a Place called *Penrhiwrllan*; the Road leading from a Place called *Blaenporth* in the Parish of *Blaenporth* aforesaid, through the said Parish, the Parish of *Llangoedmore*, and the Parish or Chapelry of *Llechryd*, to *Llechryd Bridge* on the said River *Teifi*; the Road leading from *Llechryd Bridge* aforesaid, through the Parish or Chapelry of *Llechryd* aforesaid, and the Parishes of *Llangoedmore* and *Llandigwydd*, to *Kenarth Bridge* on the said River *Teifi*; the Road leading from the present Turnpike Road on the Hill called *Goed y Cwn Bank*, through the Parish of *Llandigwydd*, to *Kenarth Bridge* aforesaid; which said Roads shall be and be called the *Cardigan* or First District of the said Roads; and also the Road leading from the Town of *Lampeter* to *Lampeter Bridge*; and also from the Town of *Lampeter*, by the Village of *Talsarn*, to the Town of *Aberystwyth*; and from a certain Place called *Aberayron*, on the Road leading from *Cardigan*, to the said Town of *Aberystwyth*; and from the said Town of *Aberystwyth* to a certain Place called *Llyfnant*, at the Borders of the County of *Montgomery*, on the Road leading to the Town of *Machynlleth*; and also from the Town of *Aberystwyth* to a certain Place called *Penrbyn*, at the Borders of the County of *Merioneth*, on the Road leading to *Aberdovy*; and also from the Town of *Aberystwyth* to a Place called *Steddva*, at the Borders of the County of *Montgomery*, on the Road leading to the Town of *Llanidloes*; and from the said Town of *Aberystwyth* to the Extremity of the County of *Cardigan*, at the Borders of the County of *Radnor*, on the Road leading to the Town of *Rayader*; and also from the Town of *Lampeter*, by the Town of *Tregaron*, to the Extremity of the County of

of *Cardigan*, on the Road leading to the Town of *Rayader*; the Road leading from the Sea Side near *Aberayron*, through the Parishes of *Henfenniw*, *Llanerchayron*, *Ciliau-Ayron*, and *Llanfichangel-Tstrad*, to join the present Turnpike Road leading from *Aberystwyth* to *Lampeter-pont-Stephen*; the Road leading from the Town of *Tregaron*, through the Parishes of *Caron*, *Llanddewi-brevi*, *Llanbadarn-odwyn*, *Llangeitho*, *Nantcwnlle*, *Trevilan*, *Llanfichangel-Tstrad*, and *Dihewyd*, to join the last-mentioned Road leading from *Aberayron Bridge* to *Lampeter-pont-Stephen* aforesaid; and also the Road leading from *Aberystwyth* aforesaid to the Town of *Tregaron* aforesaid, through the Parishes of *Llanbadarn-fawr*, *Llanychaiarn*, *Llanilar*, *Rhosdie*, *Lledrod*, *Llanddewi-brevi*, and *Caron*; also the Road leading through the Parish of *Llanbadarn-fawr* from the *Aberystwyth* North Turnpike Gate, through the Village of *Llanbadarn-fawr* aforesaid, by or near a Place called *Tynllydiart*, over *Ponterwyd*, to join the Turnpike Road leading from the Town of *Aberystwyth* aforesaid, to the Town of *Llanidloes* in the County of *Montgomery*, at or near a certain Place called *Dyffryn Castell*; and also the Road leading from a certain Bridge called *Ponteinon*, over the Mountain called *Mynydd-bach*, through the several Parishes of *Caron*, *Llanddewibrefi*, and *Llanrhystid*, and to enter the Turnpike Road leading from the Town of *Lampeter* to the Town of *Aberystwyth* aforesaid at or near a Place called *Frwd*, in the said Parish of *Llanrhystid*; and which said several last-mentioned Roads shall be and be called the *Aberystwyth* or Second District of the said Roads.

III. V. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Trustees hereby appointed for the said *Cardigan* and *Aberystwyth* Districts of Roads respectively, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, at any Meeting to be held for that Purpose, to nominate and appoint any Number of Persons not exceeding Three in the whole for each of the said Districts of Roads to be Trustees for the Purposes of this Act for the said respective Districts, in addition to the Trustees herein-named for such Districts; and such additional Trustees so to be appointed, being duly qualified, shall have the like Powers and Authorities for executing this Act as if they had been herein named.

VI. And be it enacted, That the Trustees for the said *Cardigan* District of Roads shall hold their First Meeting at the Shire Hall in the Town of *Cardigan*, or at some other Place on or near to the last-mentioned District of Roads, on the Third *Thursday* next after the passing of this Act, or as soon after as conveniently may be, between the Hours of Ten and Eleven in the Forenoon; and the Trustees for the said *Aberystwyth* District of Roads shall hold their First Meeting at the Town Hall in *Aberystwyth*, or at some other convenient Place on or near the said last-mentioned District of Roads, on the Fourth *Thursday* after the passing of this Act, between the Hours of Ten and Eleven in the Forenoon, or as soon after as conveniently be; and the said respective Meetings shall and may be adjourned from Time to Time to such Times and Places on or near to the said Roads, as the said Trustees, or the major Part of them

them present at such respective Meetings shall think proper and appoint.

VII. And be it enacted, That the several Gates, Turnpikes, and Toll Houses erected and now standing across or on the Sides of the said Roads shall remain and continue until removed by any Order or Orders of the said Trustees; and it shall be lawful for the said Trustees to order and cause to be erected and built, or set up and placed, such other Turnpikes or Toll Houses in or across the said Roads, or any of them, or any Part thereof, or by the Sides thereof, when, where, and as they shall judge necessary, in addition to or instead of all or any of the Turnpikes and Toll Houses now standing or being on the said Roads, and also from Time to Time to order and cause to be taken down and removed, or altered or discontinued, the same present Turnpikes and Toll Houses, and such future Turnpikes and Toll Houses, or any of them, as they the said Trustees shall think proper; provided that no more Toll shall be demanded or taken upon any of the said Roads than is herein-after mentioned.

Power to continue and erect Toll Gates.

VIII. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the said Trustees within their respective Districts, or for any Person under their Authority, to demand and take the Tolls following at the several Turnpike Gates or Side Bars continued, erected, or placed by virtue of this Act in, upon, across, or on or near the Side or Sides of the said Roads or any Part thereof before any Horse or other Beast, Cattle, or Carriage shall be permitted to pass through any of the said Turnpike Gates or Side Bars; that is to say,

Power to take Tolls.

For every Horse or other Beast drawing any Coach, Berlin, Landau, Chariot, Chaise, Calash, Chair, Caravan, Hearse, or Litter, Curricule, Gig, or any such like Carriage, the Sum of Sixpence :

Tolls.

And for every Horse or other Beast drawing any narrow-wheeled Waggon, Wain, Cart, or other Carriage of the like Description, the Sum of Four-pence :

For every Horse, Mule, or Ass, laden or unladen, and not drawing, the Sum of One Penny Halfpenny :

For every Drove of Oxen, Cows, or Neat Cattle, the Sum of Ten-pence *per* Score, and so in proportion for any greater or less Number :

For every Drove of Calves, Hogs, Sheep, or Lambs, the Sum of Five-pence *per* Score, and so in proportion for any greater or less Number :

Which said several and respective Tolls hereby granted shall be and are hereby vested in the Trustees of such respective Districts, and shall be applied for the Purposes of this Act in the Manner herein-after directed.

IX. Provided always, and be it enacted, That One Half only of the Toll herein-before mentioned shall be demanded or taken at any of the said Turnpikes or Toll Gates on the said Roads, or any of them, between the First Day of *March* and the Thirtieth Day of *September*, for any Horse or other Beast drawing any Waggon, Cart, or other Carriage, laden, or going empty to be laden, or returning empty from having been laden, with Lime or Limestone for manuring any Garden or other Land or Ground; and in case Payment shall have been made at any Turnpike or Toll Gate in respect of any Horse or other Beast so employed, such

Exemption of Lime for Manure between the 1st March and the 30th September.

Horse or other Beast shall, upon a Ticket denoting the Payment of such Toll on that Day being produced, be permitted to pass Toll-free at any Time during the same Day through the same Turnpike or Toll Gate, and such other Turnpikes or Toll Gates on the said Roads as the Ticket for such Payment shall free.

X. And be it enacted, That in case One full Toll shall have been paid at any Turnpike or Toll Gate on either of the said Districts of Road in respect of any Horse, Beast, or Cattle, no further Toll shall be demanded or paid in respect of the same Horse, Beast, or Cattle on the same Day at any other Turnpike or Toll Gate which shall be standing or placed within Ten Miles from the Turnpike or Toll Gate at which such Payment shall have been made.

XI. And be it enacted, That when the Tolls authorized to be taken by virtue of this Act shall have been paid for or in respect of any Horse or other Beast or Cattle at any of the Toll Gates erected or to be erected on, upon, or across the said Roads or any of them, or upon the Sides thereof, such Horse or other Beast or Cattle (except as herein-after mentioned) shall on the same Day be permitted to pass and return once through the same Toll Gate, without being subject to the Payment of any further Toll, upon the Production of a Note or Ticket denoting such Payment in respect of such Horse, Beast, or Cattle; but if any Horse or other Beast or Cattle (except as herein-before mentioned) shall pass through any such Toll Gate a Third Time, then and in any such Case Payment shall again be made of the said Toll in respect of any such Horse, Beast, or Cattle, and so *toties quoties* for every Third Time the same Horse or other Beast or Cattle (except as herein-before mentioned) shall pass the same Day through the same Toll Gate.

XII. And be it enacted, That in respect of all Horses or other Beasts drawing any Stage Coach or other Carriage whatsoever conveying Passengers or Goods for Payment, Hire, or Reward, for which Toll shall have been paid for passing through any of the said Toll Gates, the Tolls hereby made payable shall be paid for every Time of passing or returning through the same Toll Gate in like Manner as if no Toll had been before paid thereat on the same Day; provided that no further or additional Toll shall be payable in respect of any such Stage Coach or other Carriage on account only of the Horses drawing the same having been changed.

XIII. And be it enacted, That the Tolls hereby made payable shall be paid for or in respect of all Horses or other Beasts drawing any Post Chaise or other Carriage for Hire for every Time of passing or repassing through any of the said Toll Gates as often as any new Hiring thereof shall take place.

XIV. And be it enacted, That all Monies which shall have been raised and produced by virtue of the said recited Acts hereby repealed within the said *Cardigan* District of Roads which shall remain undisposed of at the Time of passing this Act, and also the Monies which shall arise and be produced by or from the Tolls made payable by this Act within the same District, and all other Monies which shall arise by virtue thereof within

within the same District, shall be applied to and for the several Uses, Intents, and Purposes following; (that is to say,) in the Payment of one Moiety or equal Half Part of all the Costs, Charges, and Expences incident to and attending the obtaining and passing of this Act, and relative thereto, with Interest for the same, and in the next place in defraying the Expences of making, erecting, and keeping in repair the Toll Gates, Toll Houses, and other Buildings in the said *Cardigan* District of Roads, and of maintaining, repairing, and improving the said Roads within the said District, or otherwise in putting this Act in execution, and in paying and keeping down the Interest of all and every Sum and Sums of Money already borrowed or advanced, or that shall or may at any Time or Times hereafter be borrowed or advanced, for the Purposes aforesaid by virtue of this Act, on the Credit of the Tolls arising by virtue thereof within the said *Cardigan* District of Roads, and then in Payment of such Principal Monies, and to no other Use, Intent, or Purpose whatsoever.

XV. And be it enacted, That all Monies which shall have been raised and produced by virtue of the said recited Acts within the *Aberystwyth* District of Roads which shall remain undisposed of at the Time of passing this Act, and also the Monies which shall arise and be produced by or from the Tolls made payable by this Act within the same District, shall be applied to and for the several Uses, Intents, and Purposes following; (that is to say,) in the Payment of one Moiety or equal Half Part of all the Costs, Charges, and Expences incident to and attending the obtaining and passing of this Act, and relative thereto, with Interest for the same, and in the next place in defraying the Expences of making, erecting, and keeping in repair the Toll Gates, Toll Houses, and other Buildings within the said *Aberystwyth* District of Roads, and of maintaining, repairing, and improving the Roads within the same District, or otherwise in putting this Act in execution, and in paying and keeping down the Interest of all and every Sum and Sums of Money already borrowed or advanced, or that shall or may at any Time or Times hereafter be borrowed or advanced, for the Purposes aforesaid, by virtue of this Act, on the Credit of the Tolls arising by virtue thereof within the said *Aberystwyth* District, and then in Payment of such Principal Monies, and to no other Use, Intent, or Purpose whatsoever.

XVI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others. Public Act.

XVII. And be it enacted, That this Act shall commence upon the Third *Thursday* next after the passing thereof, and shall from thenceforth continue and be in full Force and be executed for and during the Term of Thirty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.
