## CHAPTER 43.

An Act to enable the Colonial Probates Act, 1892, to be applied to certain Protected States and  $\lceil 22 \text{nd December } 1927. \rceil$ Mandated Territories.

A.D. 1927.

DE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, D by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. The power of His Majesty to apply the Colonial Extension Probates Act, 1892, to British possessions shall include a power to apply the said Act to any territories, being either territories under His Majesty's protection or territories in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the protected League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty, states and to which it cannot be applied by virtue of the provisions mandated of the Foreign Jurisdiction Acts, 1890 and 1913, and the said Act shall accordingly have effect as if references therein to British possessions included references to such territories as aforesaid.

2. This Act may be cited as the Colonial Probates Short title. (Protected States and Mandated Territories) Act, 1927, and the Colonial Probates Act, 1892, and this Act may be cited together as the Colonial Probates Acts, 1892 and 1927.
