^{F1}28 Identification of trees.

A person authorised by the [^{F2}appropriate forestry authority] may take such steps, whether by marking or otherwise, as the [^{F2}appropriate forestry authority] consider necessary for identifying trees which are the subject of a felling licence or felling directions, or in respect of which a felling licence has been refused.]
