1967 CHAPTER 77

PART I

ORGANISATION OF POLICE FORCES

General provisions

16 Declaration to be made by constables on appointment.

A person appointed to the office of constable of a police force shall on appointment make, before a sheriff, [^{F1}or justice of the peace], a declaration in such terms as may be prescribed concerning the proper discharge of the duties of the office.
