## PART IV

## FURTHER POWERS OF CERTAIN AUTHORITIES

### 57 Supplementary provisions as to byelaws.

- (1) Sections [<sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>202] to 204] of the Local Government (Scotland) Act [<sup>F1M1</sup>1973] (which relate to the procedure for making byelaws, penalties and the proof of byelaws in legal proceedings) shall apply to byelaws made by [<sup>F3</sup>Scottish Natural Heritage] or a local planning authority or an Electricity Board under section 54, . . . <sup>F4</sup> or section 64 of this Act as if [<sup>F3</sup>Scottish Natural Heritage] or authority or Board were a local authority within the meaning of the said Act of [<sup>F1</sup>1973].
- (2) In relation to byelaws made under the said section 54 . . . <sup>F4</sup> or the said section 64 the confirming authority for the purposes of [<sup>F1</sup>section 202 of the said Act of 1973] shall be the Secretary of State.
